## alliteration:

repetition of the same letter sound at the beginning of words.

### clause:

grammatical units that make up a sentence.

## omniscient:

all-seeing and all-knowing; used to describe a style of narration.

#### assonance:

repetition of vowel sounds within a sentence or phrase.

#### connote:

verb from of connotation; to imply or suggest something beyond the literal meaning of a word.

## onomatopoeia:

when a word's sound closely depicts its meaning.

# character:

an individual within a text – also refers to their distinctive personality traits and moral qualities.

## metaphor:

one thing is said to be another so as to draw a comparison between them.

### sentence:

grammatical unit consisting of at least one clause

# **Shakespeare:**

poet, playwright and actor widely regarded as the greatest practitioner of the English language the world has known.

## simile:

the drawing of similarities between two things using the word 'like' or 'as'.
