

Royal Wedding: Time Word Problems

Work out the answers to the following time word problems about the Royal Wedding.

1. The wedding invitations have been sent out and the guests have 14 weeks to reply. How many months and weeks is that?

2. If it takes the Royal Seamstress 5 months and 3 weeks to make the bridal gown, how many weeks is that?

3. If the wedding ceremony is expected to last 85 minutes, what is that in hours and minutes?

4. If it takes Meghan approximately 9 minutes to get to the chapel, what is that in seconds?

5. If the wedding meal lasted 195 minutes from start to finish, how many hours and minutes would this be?

6. By the time they marry on the 19th May 2018, Prince Harry and Meghan will have been engaged for 24 weeks and 5 days. How many days is this altogether?

7. If it is 10 weeks until the Royal Wedding day, how many months and weeks is there to wait?

8. If the happy couple pose for photographs for 36 minutes, how many seconds is that equal to?

9. If the wedding event lasts for 386 minutes altogether, how many hours and minutes is that?

10. By Christmas Day 2018, Prince Harry and Meghan will have been married for 220 days. What is this in weeks and days?

2. 5 months and 3 weeks = 23 weeks
3. 85 minutes = 1 hour 25 minutes
4. 9 minutes = 540 seconds
5. 195 minutes = 3 hours 15 minutes
6. 24 weeks and 5 days = 173 days
7. 10 weeks = 2 months 2 weeks
8. 36 minutes = 2160 seconds
9. 386 minutes = 6 hours 26 minutes
10. 220 days = 31 weeks 3 days
