


Tissue Box Guitar




Materials:


- one empty tissue box per student
- four large rubber bands per student
- one empty paper towel roll per student
- tape
- scissors
- white glue
- markers or crayons
- glitter




Instructions:

- 1. Remove any plastic film from the hole on the tissue box.
- 2. Have your teacher cut out a hole at one end of the box.
- 3. Insert a paper towel roll into the hole. This will be your guitar neck.
- 4. Secure the paper towel roll to the tissue box with tape.
- 5. Add the rubber bands around the tissue box.
- 6. The rubber bands will lay over the gap of the tissue box.
- 7. Decorate your guitar using markers or crayons.
- 8. Add some designs to your guitar using glue and glitter.
- 9. Allow to dry completely.
- 10. Play your new guitar!






