What Is April Fools' Day?

April Fools' Day is a day when people play tricks and jokes on each other.



When Is April Fools' Day?

April Fools' Day in Britain always takes place on 1st April.



Tricks can only be played in the morning in England. The joke is on you if you play a trick after 12 o'clock!

Remember to plan April Fools' Day jokes and tricks that don't hurt people's feelings.

What Is April Fools' Day?

April Fools' Day is sometimes called All Fools' Day. It is celebrated every year on 1st April in Britain and people play tricks and jokes on each other.

Sometimes people tell hoax stories to trick people.

Did You Know...?

A hoax is when you trick somebody into believing something that isn't true.

Remember to plan April Fools' Day jokes and tricks that don't hurt people's feelings.

England



- People play tricks and jokes on their friends.
- Tricks must be played before 12 o'clock. The joke is on you if you play a trick after 12 o'clock!

France



- April Fools' Day is called 'Poisson d'Avril'.
- People tape paper fish onto their friends' backs.
- People shout "Poisson d'Avril!" when their friends find the fish. 'Poisson d'Avril' is 'April Fish' in English.

Portugal



- April Fools' Day is celebrated on 1st April.
- People throw flour at their friends.

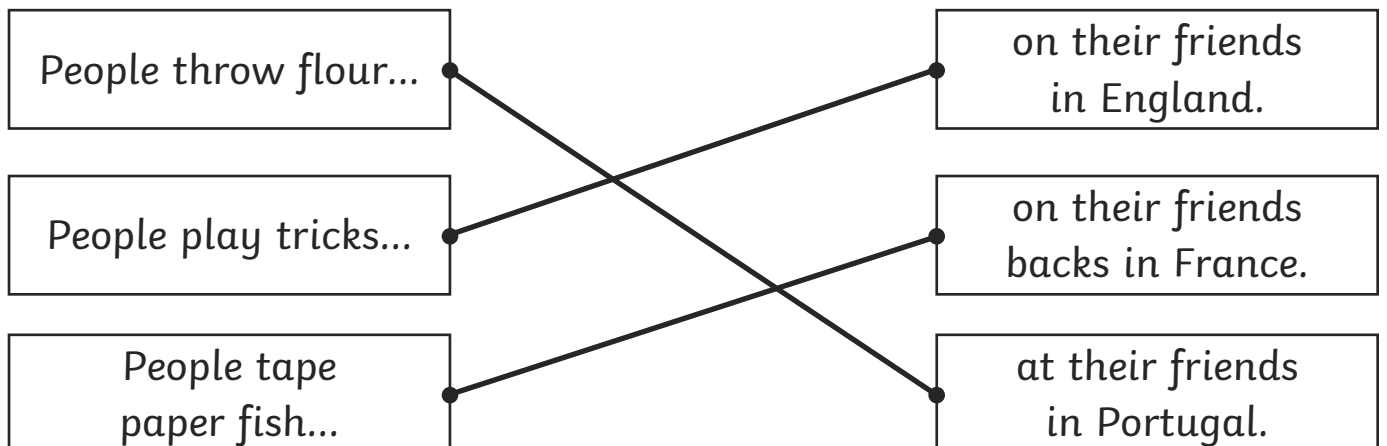

People play tricks and jokes on their friends in England. They must do this before 12 o'clock. The joke is on you if you play a trick after 12 o'clock!



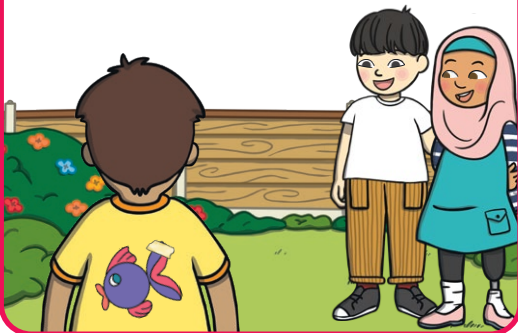
April Fools' Day is called 'Poisson d'Avril' in France. 'Poisson d'Avril' translates to 'April Fish'. It also means 'Happy April Fools' Day!'

April Fools' Day is sometimes called All Fools' Day. It is celebrated every year on 1st April.

Sometimes people tell hoax stories to trick people.

Did You Know...?

A hoax is when you trick somebody into believing something that isn't true.



People tape paper fish onto their friends' backs and shout "Poisson d'Avril!" when the fish is found.



The traditions of April Fools' Day last for two days on the Sunday and Monday before Lent in Portugal.

One of the main traditional pranks is to throw flour at your friends.



April Fools' Day is called 'Hunt the Gowk' in Scotland. 'Gowk' is a Scottish word that means 'cuckoo'. It is a day to send someone on a fool's errand.

A Famous Prank

The BBC played a famous prank on the public in 1957. They made a film showing people picking spaghetti from trees.

Some people even asked how they could grow their own spaghetti tree!

Remember, it is important to make sure that it doesn't hurt anyone's feelings when playing an April Fools' Day trick.

This means that you send someone to look for something that doesn't exist, such as chickens with teeth.

April Fools' Day is called Dia das Mentiras or Dia dos Bobos in Brazil.

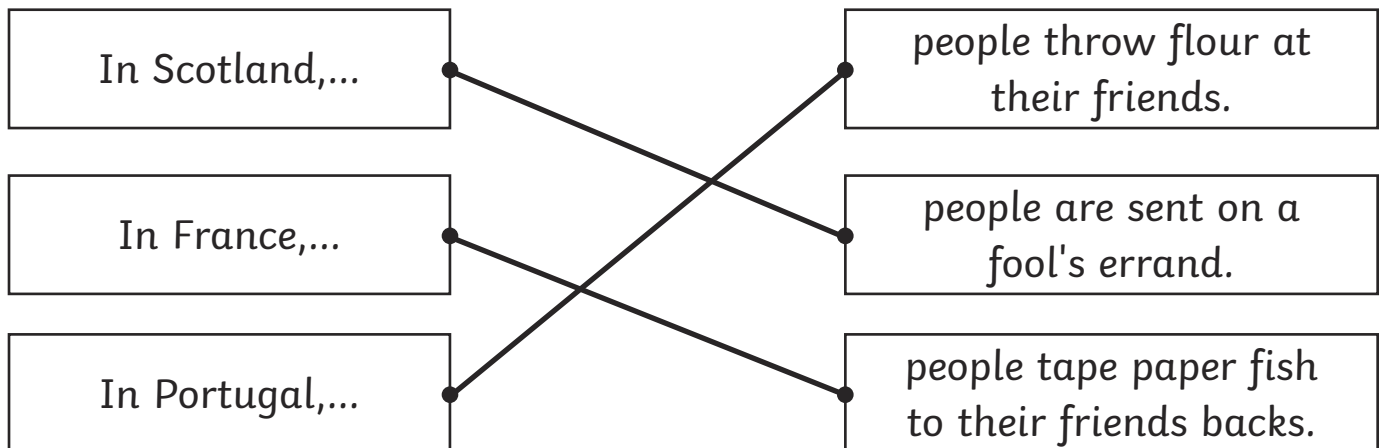
