
When a word ends with a short vowel sound and a single consonant,


double the final consonant.



When a word ends with an unvoiced **'e'**,

drop the 'e' if


the suffix begins with a vowel.



When a word ends with in an unvoiced 'e',

keep the 'e' if

the suffix begins with a consonant.




When a word ends with in 'ce' or 'ge',

drop the 'e' if

the suffix begins with 'a' or 'o'.

When a word ends in a vowel before the **'y'**,

keep the 'y'
