

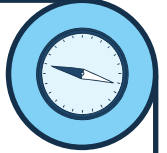

Why not use [Google Earth](#) and take a closer look at what it is like there?



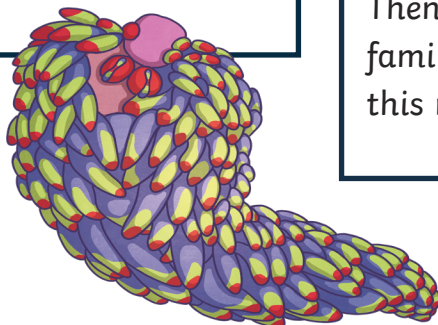
Investigate
