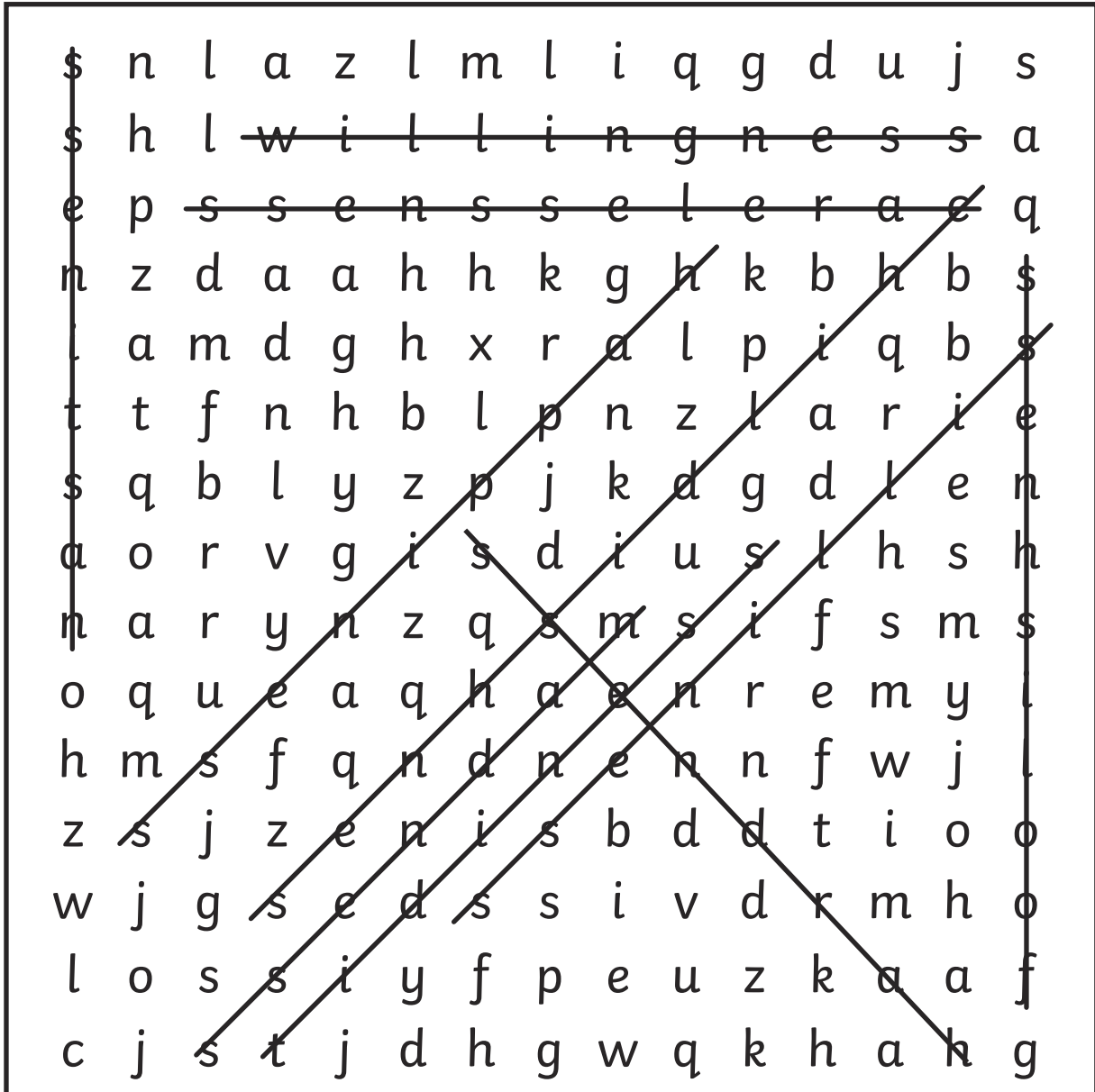

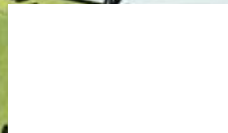


# Year 5 Term 2A Overview

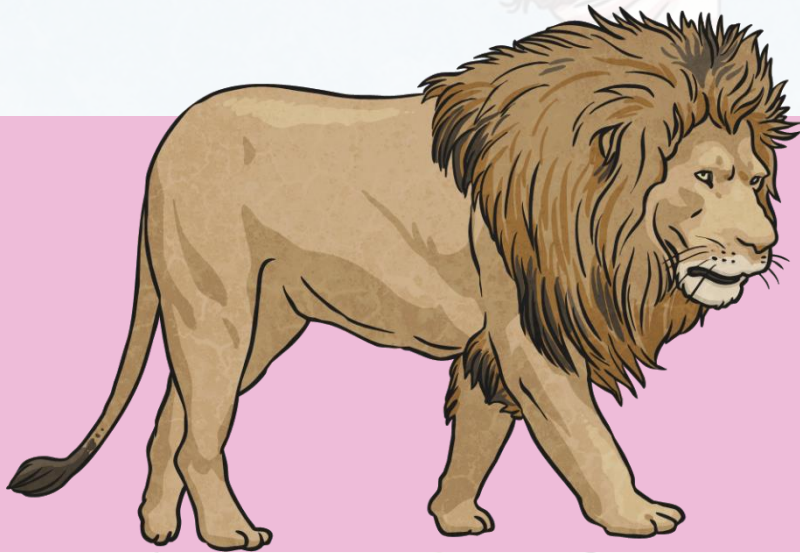
