Please accept any answer that recognises the two rules used when forming numbers using Roman numerals:

1. If a larger number symbol is followed by a smaller one, you add the two together. You also add if two symbols are the same.

$$\mathbf{XI} = 10 + 1 = 11$$

$$\mathbf{XX} = 10 + 10 = 20$$

2. If a smaller number symbol is followed by a larger number symbol you must subtract the small number from the large one.

$$\mathbf{IX} = 10 - 1 = 9$$

$$\mathbf{IV} = 5 - 1 = 4$$
