## Roman Numerals

Nina needs your help. She is struggling to read the Roman numerals below. Help Nina write the numbers in digits using the information in the box below.

I	V	X	L	C	D	M
1	5	10	50	100	500	1000

Follow these rules to help you read Roman numerals:

1. If a larger number symbol is followed by a smaller one, you add the two together. You also add if two symbols are the same.

$$DC = 500 + 100 = 600$$

$$MM = 1000 + 1000 = 2000$$

2. If a smaller number symbol is followed by a larger number symbol you must subtract the small number from the large one.

$$XC = 100 - 10 = 90$$

$$IV = 5 - 1 = 4$$

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## Roman Numerals Answers

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I	V	X	L	C	D	M
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Follow these rules to help you read Roman numerals:

1. If a larger number symbol is followed by a smaller one, you add the two together. You also add if two symbols are the same.

$$DC = 500 + 100 = 600$$

$$MM = 1000 + 1000 = 2000$$

2. If a smaller number symbol is followed by a larger number symbol you must subtract the small number from the large one.

$$XC = 100 - 10 = 90$$

$$IV = 5 - 1 = 4$$

$$CDLXXII = \mathbf{472}$$

$$DCCLIIIVI = \mathbf{786}$$

$$DCCCXLVIII = \mathbf{848}$$

$$CDXXXVIII = \mathbf{438}$$

$$CCCLVII = \mathbf{357}$$

$$CMXLVI = \mathbf{946}$$

$$DCCCLXIV = \mathbf{864}$$

$$CMLXXIII = \mathbf{973}$$
