Lesson Ideas

Curriculum Aim: Living Things and Their Habitats: Describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird.

Success Criteria:

- I can explain what mammals, amphibians, insects and birds are.
- I know how to use and make a life cycle.
- I can identify differences in life cycles.

Whole Class Demonstration Activity:

Show the children the <u>Amphibian Life Cycle Photo Pack</u>. Ask different children to come up and put the cards in the right order. Repeat this activity with the <u>Insect Life Cycle Photo Pack</u>.
