#### Number 2 Down Example Clues:

Standard clue: *The sound a goose or car horn makes* <sup>(?)</sup>

Anagram clue: *Say Hi to N Kong!* <sup>(?)</sup>

Mixed clue: *Can you hear the goose saying hi to N. Kong?* <sup>(?)</sup>

★ Challenge Task ★
