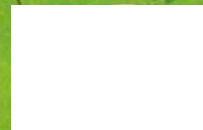
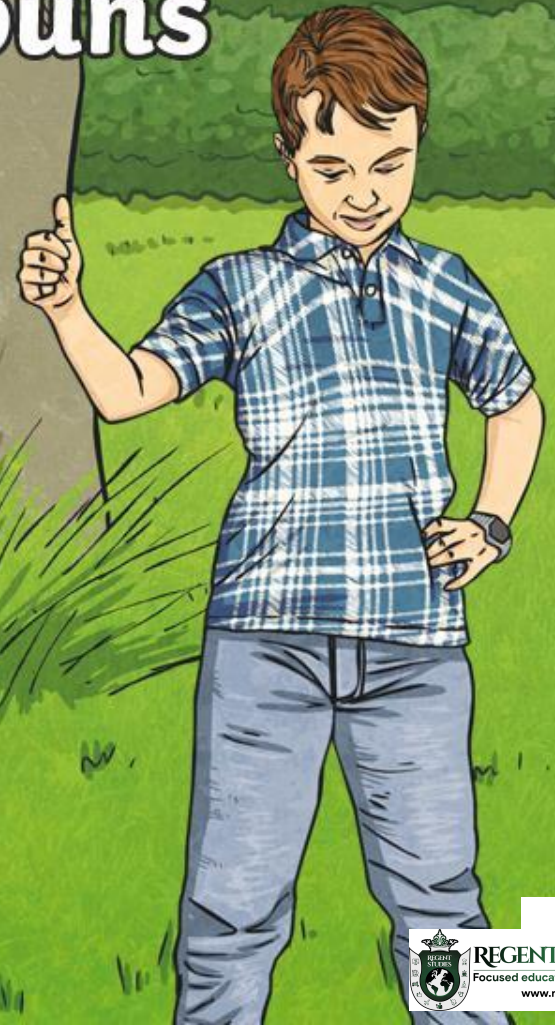


# Year 6 Term 1A Overview

For our last set of spellings, we practised spelling **-ant** adjectives that became **-ance** or **-ancy**, e.g.

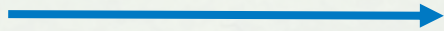


hesitant → hesitancy

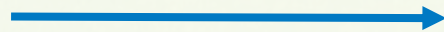

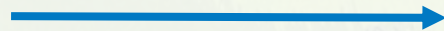

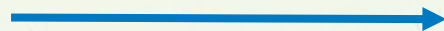
