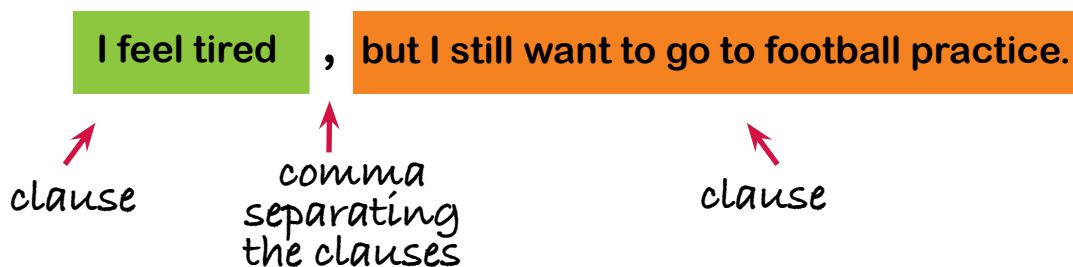


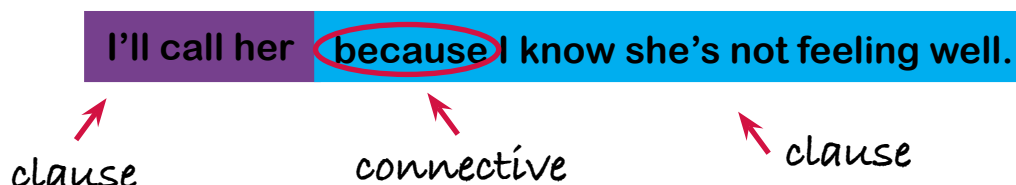
## Clauses in a sentence

When we talk about clauses in a sentence, we mean their parts.

Clauses always have a noun and a verb in them.



Clauses are often linked by a connective.



These sentences each have two clauses with a comma or connective between them. Underline each of the separate clauses.
