Play this game with a partner.

Can he/she tell you if the sentence is active or passive? Remember that a passive verb has part of the verb 'be' (is/are/am/was/were) in front of it. Turn over the card to find out!

E.g. When you **pluck** a string, it vibrates. Active

E.g. A guitar string vibrates when it *is plucked*. *Passive*
