
Taxonomy: Dichotomous Key

A **dichotomous key** is a series of questions and a useful tool for scientists to find out more about a living thing. Cut out the cards. Choose one card and go through the dichotomous key to find out about that living thing's classification. Write the classification fact you discover on the back of the card.



Dichotomous Key

1a. It has fur
1b. It does not have fur
2a. It cannot change locations (move) on its own
2b. It can change locations on its own
3a. It has a flower It belongs to the phylum Phanerogams (flowering plants).
3b. It does not have a flowerIt belongs to the phylum Cryptogams (non-flowering plants).
4a. It has feathers and can fly
4b. It cannot fly
5a. It does not have a backbone
5b. It swims in water
Challenge: Can you find the full classification of one of the cards above? (Find the Kingdom, Phylum, Class, Order, Family, Genus, and Species.)
