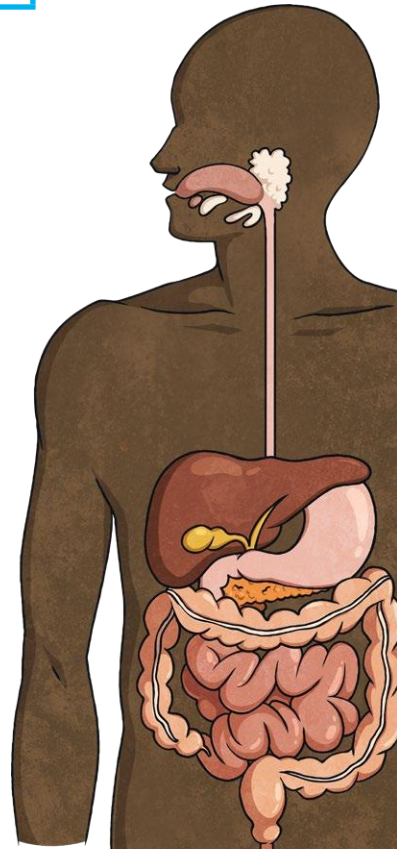
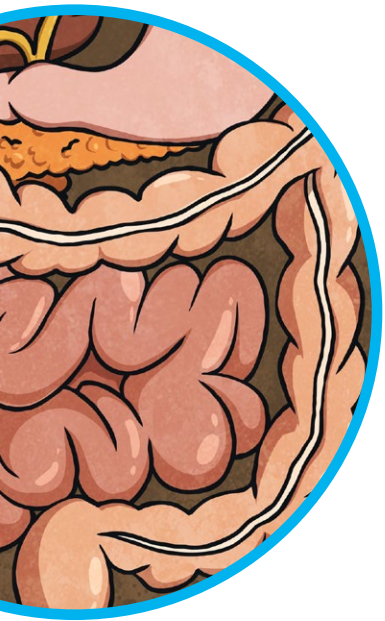
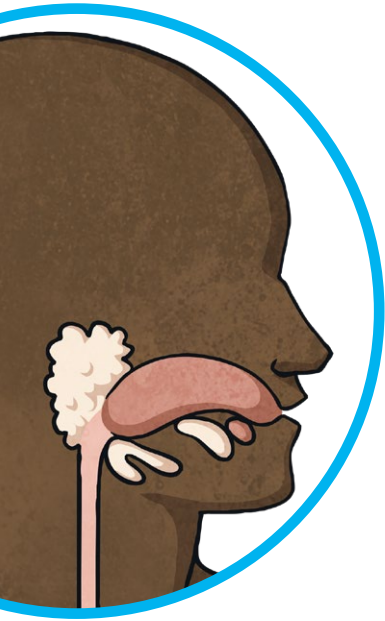


# Digestive System Crossword

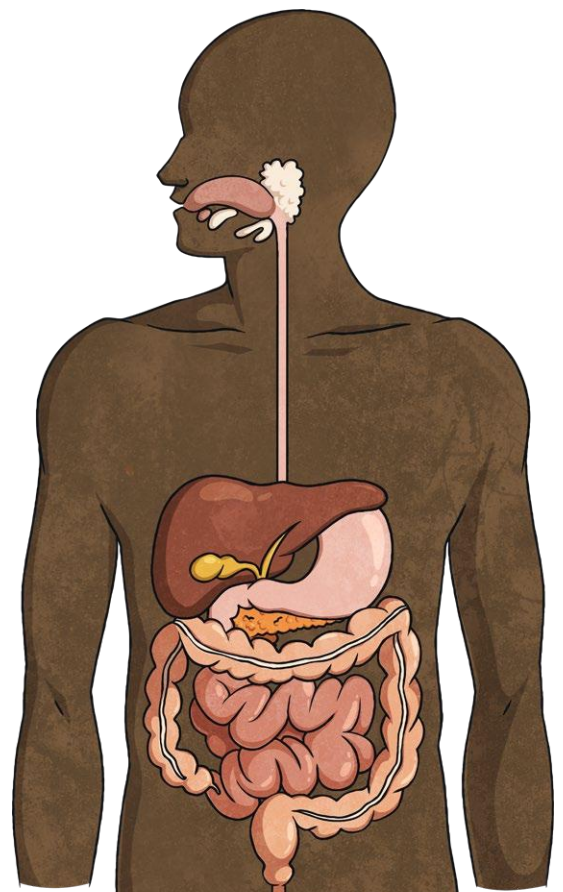
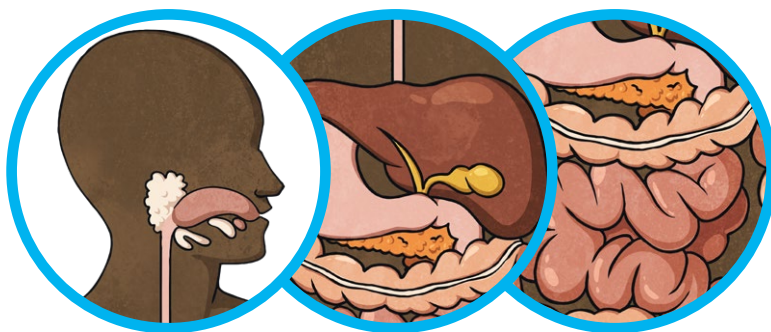

<b>5</b>	Part of the intestine where water is absorbed from remaining food waste. Faeces are also formed here.
<b>6</b>	Break down food so that it can be absorbed and used by the body.
<b>7</b>	A large organ next to the stomach that changes your food into substances that the body can use and also removes anything toxic.
<b>8</b>	An organ that produces insulin- a hormone which controls the amount of glucose in the blood and allows glucose to enter the body's cells to provide energy.
