to broadcast something using television.
6. telekinesis
a power, that cannot be explained, that allows objects to be moved without any physical contact.

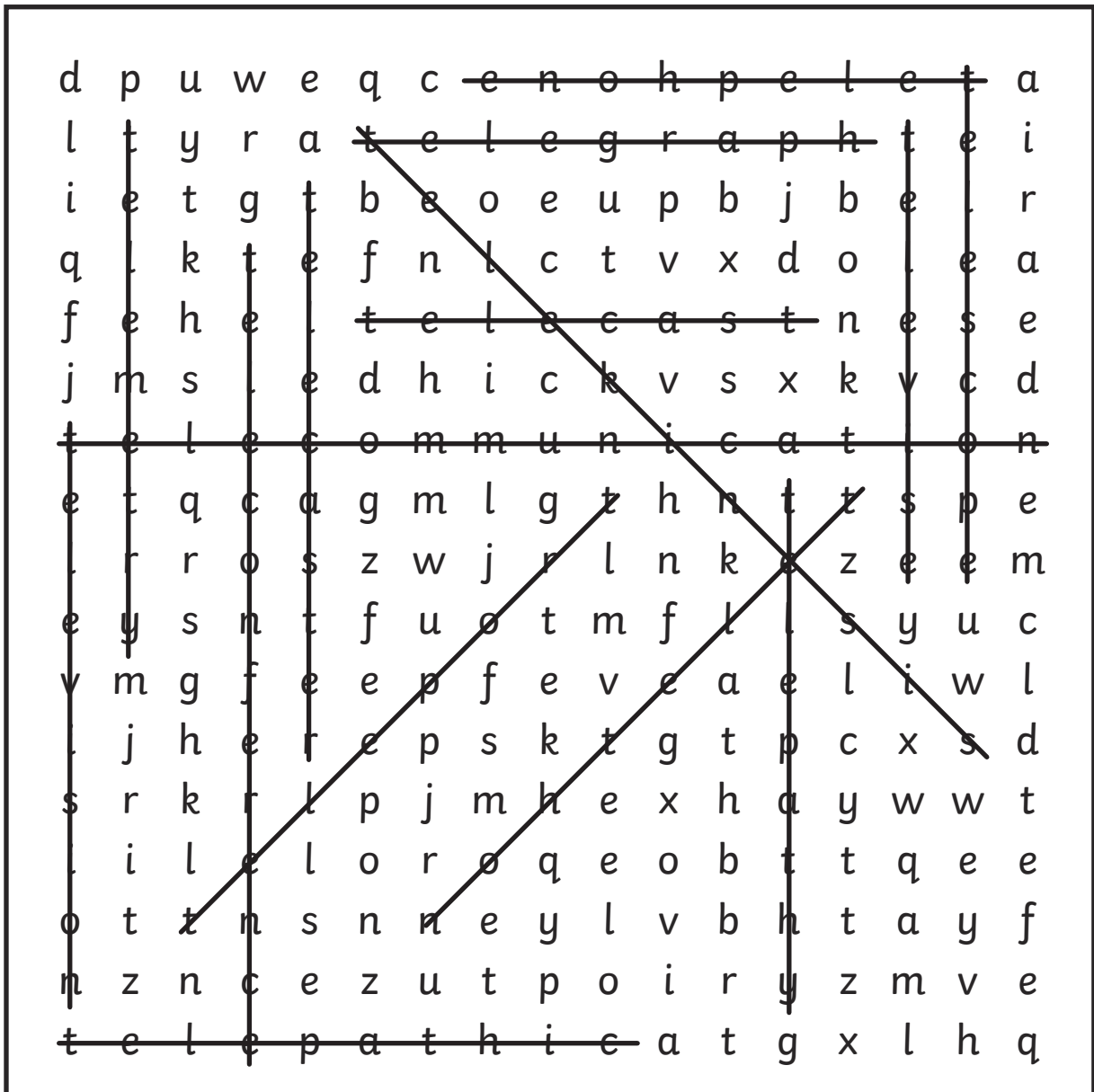
