How to play the game

A game for 4-6 players.

You will need a figurative language word fan each and a sand-timer or stopwatch.

Cut out the challenge cards and place them face down in the middle of the table.


One player chooses a card and reads the sentence out to the rest of the players.

Give a set amount of time for everyone to have a think, then each person shows which type of figurative language is given by showing the correct word on their fan.

Answer: alliteration

I wanted to audition for the play, but I got <u>cold</u> <u>feet</u> at the last moment.

Answer: idiom

I'm glad my teacher's lovely- mum says she had a teacher at school who was a real <u>dragon!</u>

Answer: metaphor

There was so much delicious food on the buffet table, it was groaning with the weight!

Answer: personification

The times tables questions <u>zipped by like</u> <u>lightning</u> and we couldn't read them fast enough.

Answer: simile

Proper presentation in your writing promotes progress!

Answer: alliteration

The prowling cat's green eyes were <u>emeralds</u> glinting in the dark.

Answer: metaphor

I know you think the others have an advantage, but we're all in the same boat; no one knows the answers.

Answer: idiom

The crowd cheered as the dazzling fireworks whooshed up into the night sky.

Answer: onomatopoeia

I'm so hungry, I could eat a horse!

Answer: hyperbole

I've lost my new phone; Dad's going to <u>kill me</u>!

Answer: hyperbole

I'll have to <u>get my act</u>
<u>together</u> if I want to get
the best result I can in
this test.

Answer: idiom

The roaring avalanche <u>devoured</u> everything in its path.

Answer: personification
