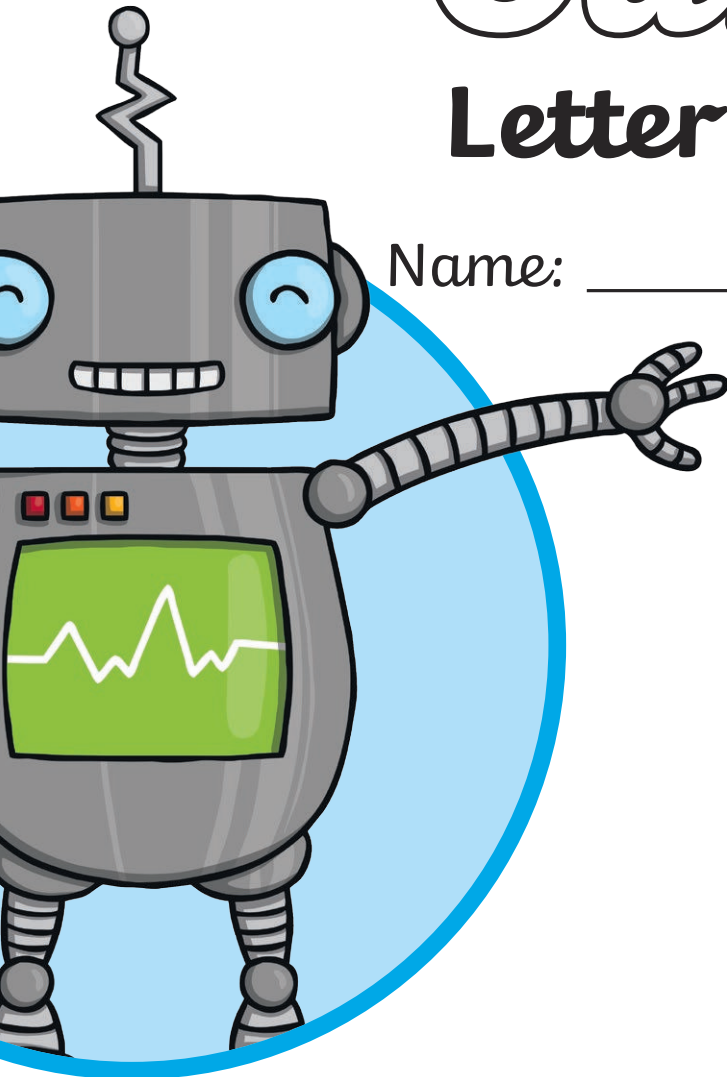


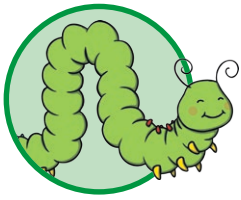

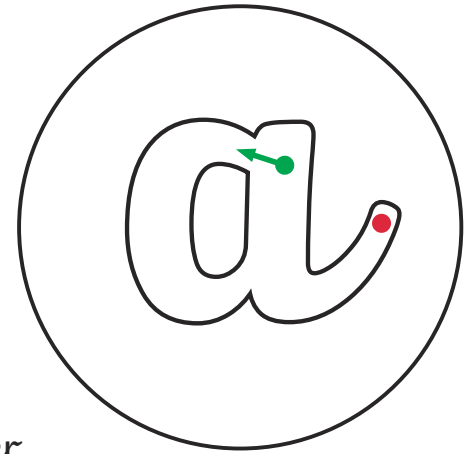




# The Letter 'a'

Go straight back down again and hooray – you made an a!

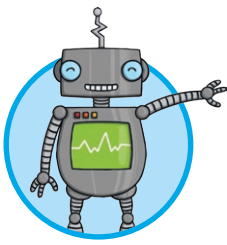

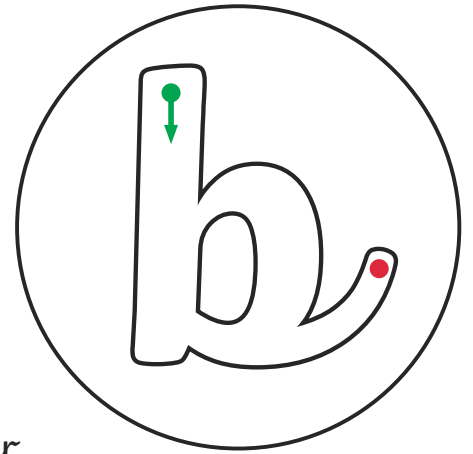







# The Letter 'b'

Curl the top, go straight down and swing to the left. Go back up and cross the belly of your f!

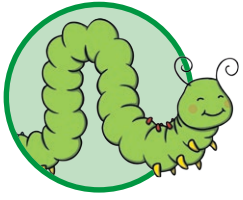
