







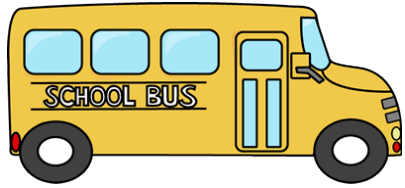


Activity 1: (beginning) 10-15 min

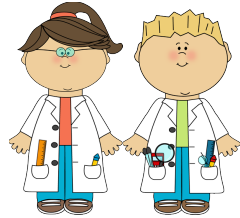
Activity 2 (next) 20-30 min

Activity 3 (last) 20-30 min Students create their own singular, plural, singular possessive and plural possessive noun sentences.



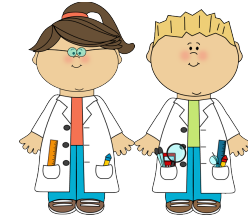
