Irregular Plurals Top Cards

How to Play

- 1. Cut out and shuffle the cards.
- 2. Deal out the cards evenly between two players.
- 3. The first player looks at (only) the top card in their pack, and reads the **singular** word on the card to the second player. This is the word at the top of the card. Your opponent must **not** be able to see or read your card!
- 4. The second player must then spell (out loud or by writing it down) the **plural** of the word. This is the word at the bottom of the card.
- 5. If they are **correct** the first player must give the second player the card and the second player then has a go with a card from their own pack.
 - If they are **incorrect**, the first player keeps their card, puts it to the back of their pack and has another go.
- 6. This continues until one player has no cards left. The player with all the cards is the winner!
