

Subject Pronouns

-) A subject pronoun is a word that takes the place of a noun as a subject of a sentence.
-) A sentence's subject is the person or thing that performs the action of a verb.
-) Subject pronouns can be singular or plural.
-) The subject pronouns are: **I, you, he, she, it, we, and they.**

For example:

-) The boy drew a circle. = **He** drew a circle.
-) The girl sharpened her pencil. = **She** sharpened her pencil.
-) The students were joyous. = **They** were joyous.
