## Subject Pronouns

- ) A subject pronoun is a word that takes the place of a noun as a subject of a sentence.
- ) A sentence's subject is the person or thing that performs the action of a verb.
- ) Subject pronouns can be singular or plural.
- ) The subject pronouns are: I, you, he, she, it, we, and they.

For example:

- ) The boy drew a circle. =  $\underline{\mathbf{He}}$  drew a circle.
- ) The girl sharpened her pencil. = <u>She</u> sharpened her pencil.
  - The students were joyous. =  $\underline{\text{They}}$  were joyous.
