- subordinating conjunctions, e.g. **because**;
- co-ordinating conjunctions, e.g. **so**;
- causal adverbials, e.g. as a result.

When Are Causal Conjunctions Used?

Causal conjunctions are used:

• **to link independent clauses in the middle of sentences** e.g. I dislike dogs, **so** I don't enjoy visiting my uncle who has four huskies.

• to link independent clauses at the beginning of a sentence e.g. Because I had forgotten my lunch, the school cook let me have a hot dinner.

• at the beginning of a sentence to refer to the sentence before e.g. I lost my homework on the way to school. **Therefore**, I will have to stay in to complete it at lunchtime.

to add cohesion within paragraphs

e.g. Many schools have a rule that children wear uniform, which most parents and children are happy with. Wearing a school uniform means that pupils all look the same and nobody feels different. **Accordingly**, most pupils attend school looking smart and feeling proud to be part of their school.




