Past



## Past Perfect Progressive

Also known as **Past Perfect Continuous**.

Describes actions that were in progress up to the moment when another action took place.

**Example: I had been walking the dog for an hour when her lead snapped.**

# Perfect Progressive Tense

Present

Dog Walk...

Now

## Present Perfect Progressive

Also known as **Present Perfect Continuous**.

Describes events which started at some point in that past which may not be finished.

Example: I have been walking the dog for an hour.

## Future Perfect Progressive

Also known as **Future Perfect Continuous**.

Describes events which will have taken place for some time and not yet be finished.

Example: I will have been walking the dog for an hour by the time she meets me tonight.



Past



## Past Perfect

Describes completed events of the past which happened before another action took place.

**Example:** I had already walked the dog when my friend rang.

# Perfect Tenses



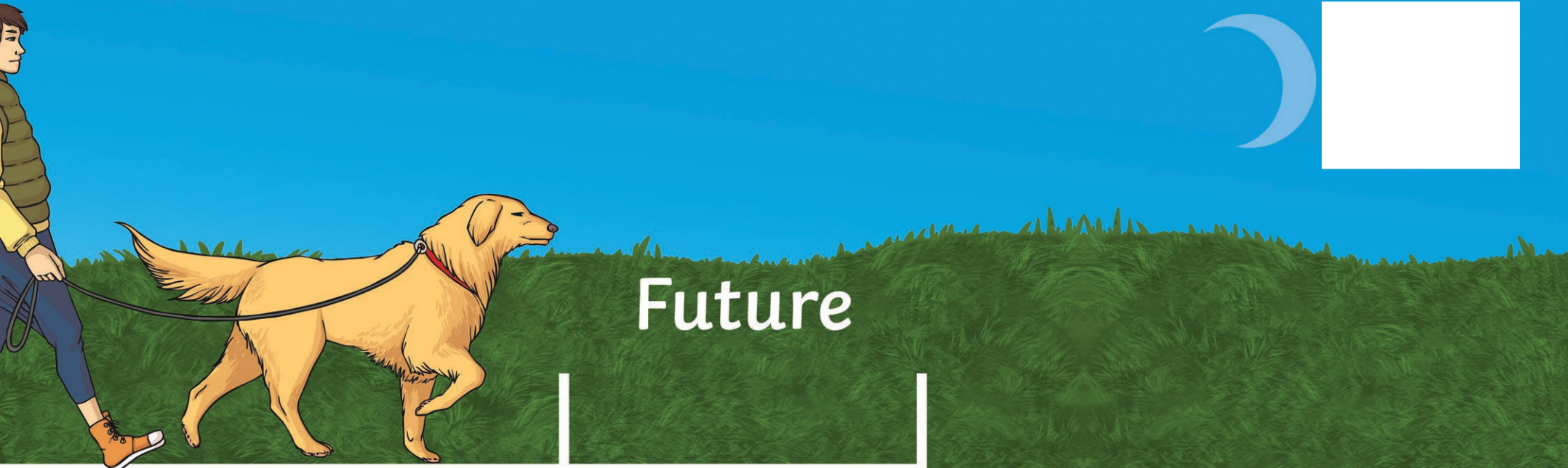
Present



## Present Perfect

Describes events which started in the past and continued up until now.

**Example: I have just walked the dog.**



Future

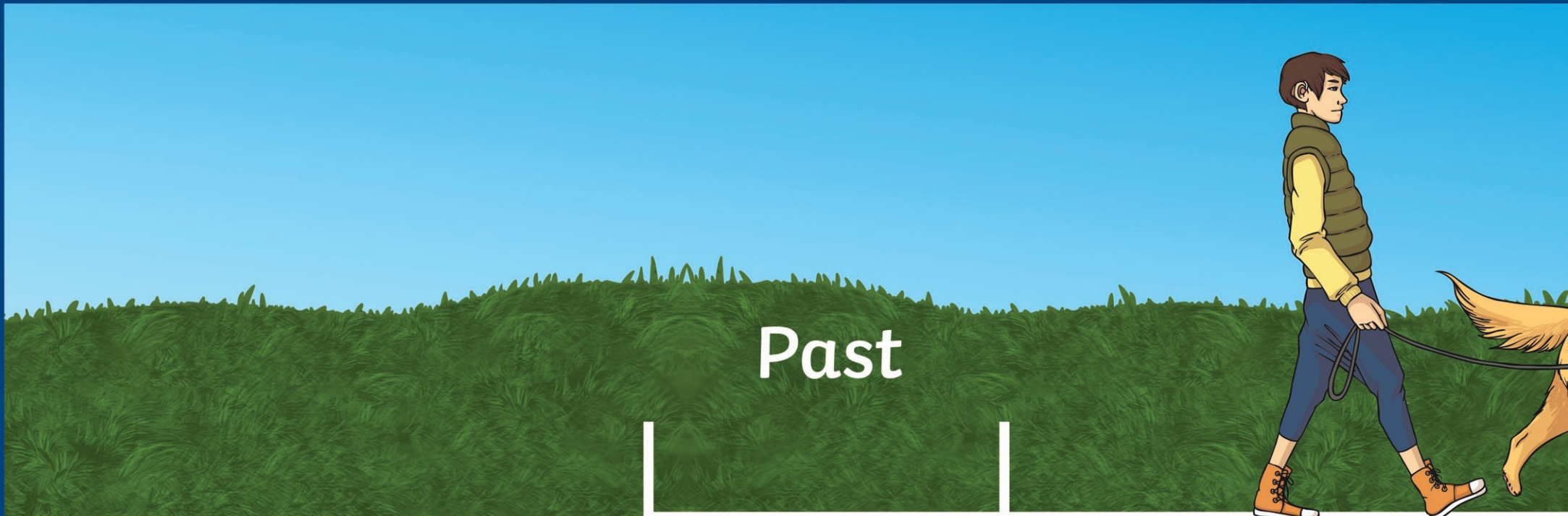
Dog Walk →

## Future Perfect

Describes events which will be finished before another action takes place.

**Example: I will have walked the dog by the time my friend rings.**



Past

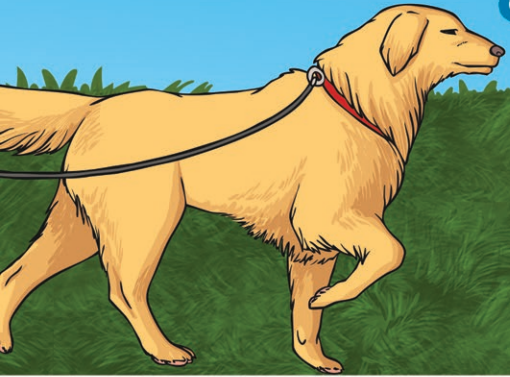
← Walking the dog →

## Past Progressive

Also known as **Past Continuous**.  
Describes events which happened in  
the past over a period of time.

**Example: I was walking the dog.**

# Progressive Tenses



Present

## Present Progressive

Also known as **Present Continuous**.  
Describes events which are happening  
right now in the present moment.

**Example: I am walking the dog.**

## Future Progressive

Also known as **Future Continuous**.

Describes events which will take place over time.

**Example: I will be walking the dog.**



Past

## Simple Past

Also known as **Past Simple**.

Describes events which happened at a specific time but are now completed.

**Example: I walked the dog earlier today.**

# Simple Tenses

Present

## Simple Present

Also known as **Present Simple**.  
Describes events which happen  
often in the present.

**Example: I walk the dog every day.**



Future

## Simple Future

Also known as **Future Simple**.  
Describes events which will take place  
**Example: I will walk the dog tomorrow.**
