SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT

Rule 1: Use singular verb with a singular subject.

Examples:

1. Sheena loves studying grammar.
2. John is an intelligent student.
3. My mother has baked a chocolate cake for guests.

Rule 3: Use a plural verb for subject(s) joined with 'and'.
