Extra points

What's the difference between been and gone?

Click to reveal the answer:

'Been' is used for when you went and returned. 'Gone' is used when you're still at that place. E.g. 'I've been to the shops' (I went and returned). 'She's gone to the shops' (she's there now).

What's the difference between got and gotten?

Click to reveal the answer:

'Got' is more common in British English, 'gotten' is more common in American English.

Rules of the Game

This game will help you revise irregular verbs.

You must help an alien, **Bumper**, choose the right verb in the past participle and step on the right stone to avoid the lava. If you choose the wrong stone, you must go back to the beginning of the game.

Everyone can join in by shouting '**The floor is lava!**' If that happens, everyone must make sure that they aren't touching the floor by jumping on a chair or other furniture.



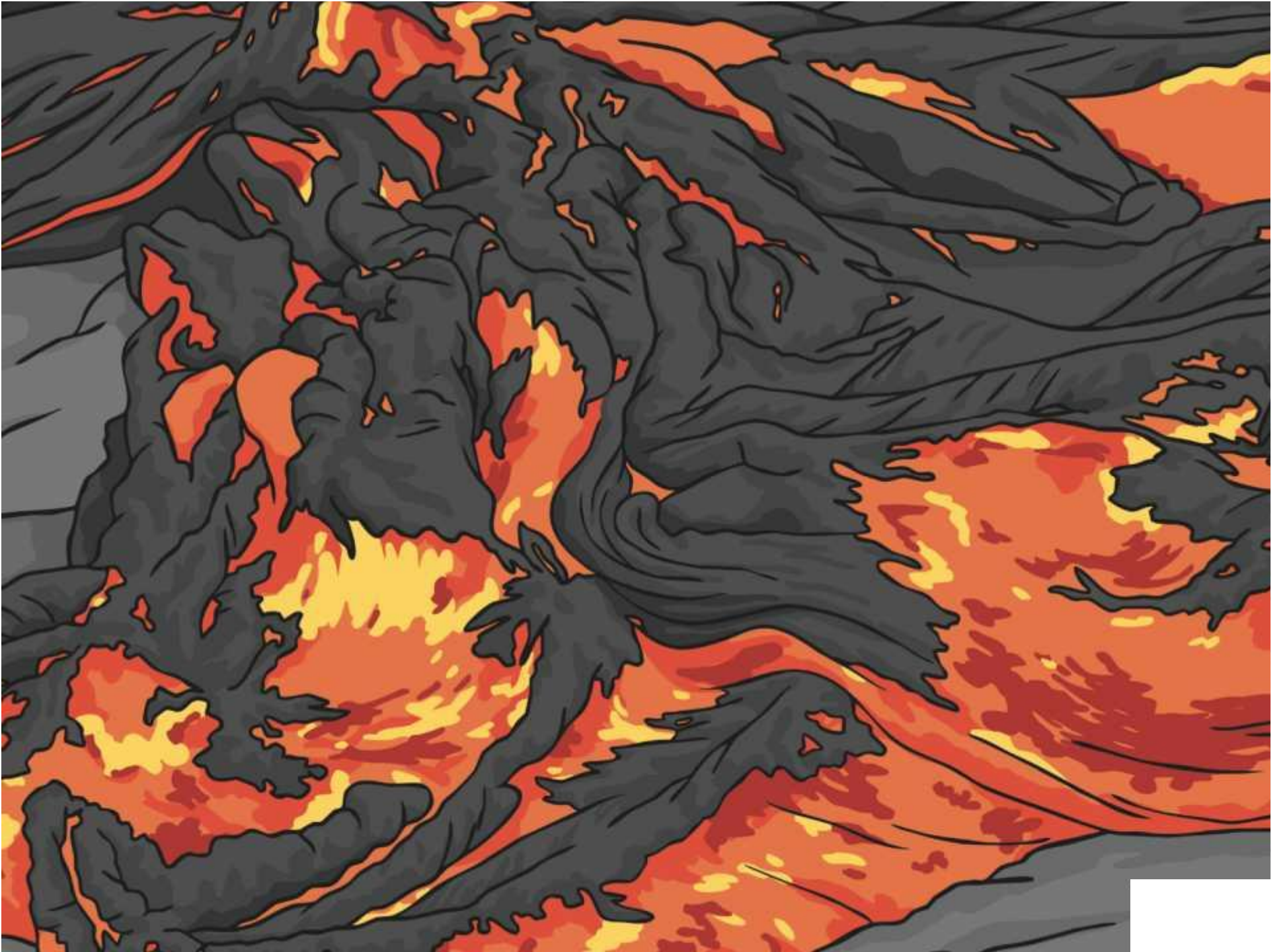
