

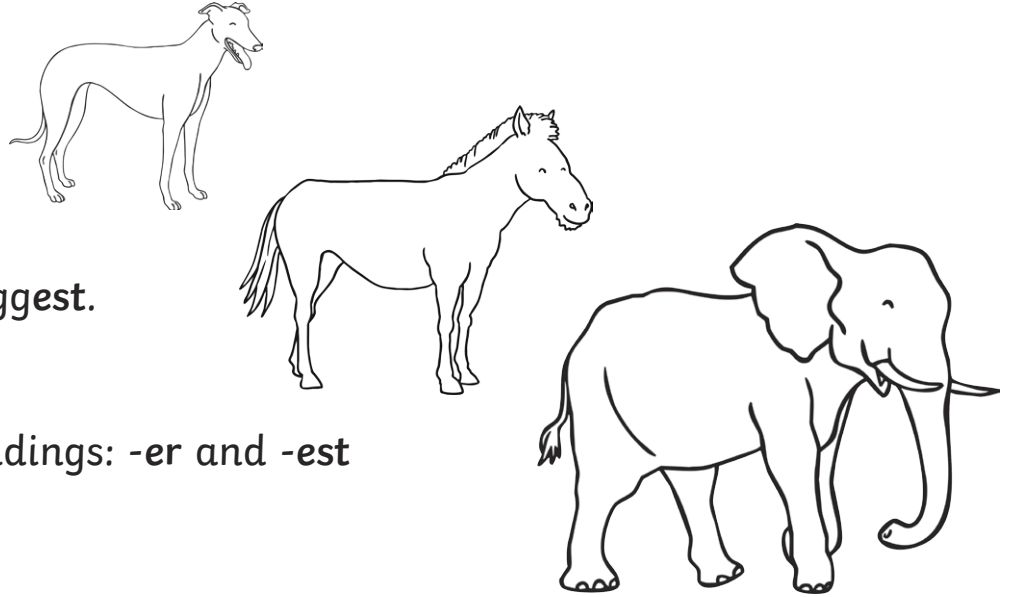
# Comparing Adjectives

When comparing two nouns we use a comparative adjective.

An adjective is a describing word.

For example:

- The dog is big.
- The horse is bigger.
- The elephant is the biggest.



Notice the use of the endings: -er and -est

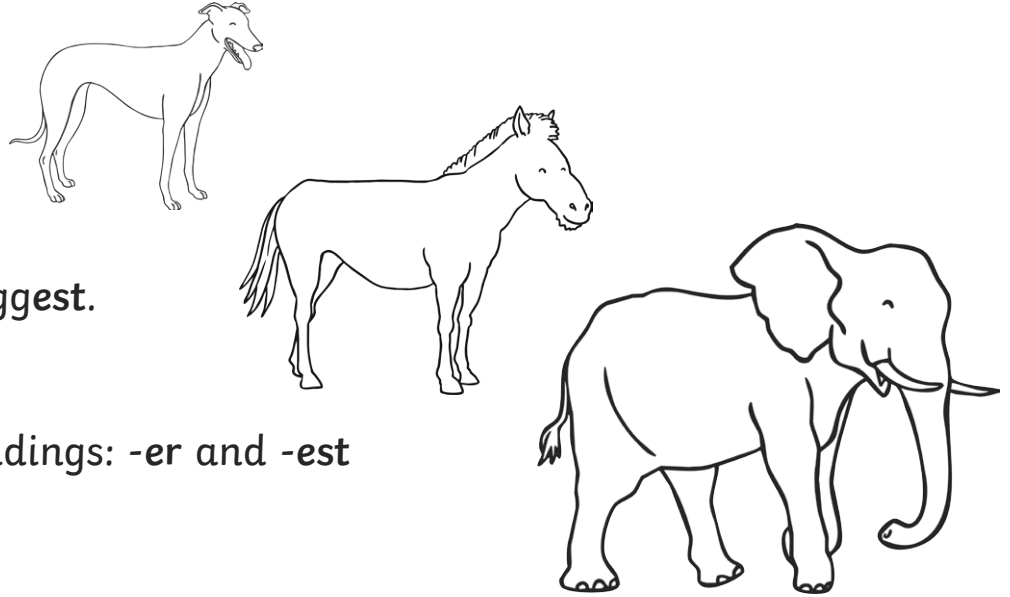
# Comparing Adjectives Answers
