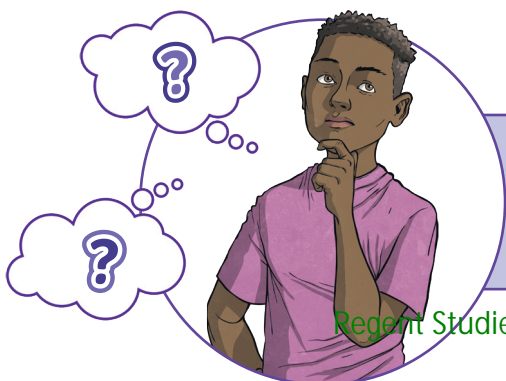


Correlative Conjunctions

Correlative conjunctions are when a pair of conjunctions relate to and support each other in a sentence. They connect words and phrases that are equally important in the sentence. They are a great way of adding more information to a sentence.

Conjunctions	Example
neither + nor	I wanted neither the cake nor the brownie.
either + or	You should either go to the park or to the beach.
not only + but also	I'll take not only the shoes but also the bag.
no sooner + than	It turned out that no sooner had I messaged my friend than he knocked on my door.
as many + as	There were as many adults as there were children at the lolly shop.
