## **Correlative Conjunctions**

Correlative conjunctions are when a pair of conjunctions relate to and support each other in a sentence. They connect words and phrases that are equally important in the sentence. They are a great way of adding more information to a sentence.

Conjunctions	Example
neither + nor	I wanted <b>neither</b> the cake <b>nor</b> the brownie.
either + or	You should <b>either</b> go to the park <b>or</b> to the beach.
not only + but also	I'll take <b>not only</b> the shoes <b>but also</b> the bag.
no sooner + than	It turned out that <b>no sooner</b> had I messaged my friend <b>than</b> he knocked on my door.
as many + as	There were <b>as many</b> adults <b>as</b> there were children at the lolly shop.
