
Notes for the Teacher

This warm-up PowerPoint is intended to be used as revision for Key Stage 1 pupils.


The games and activities on these slides can be used one at a time as introductory activities or as lesson starters.

Can you describe each of these animals using a list of three adjectives? Don't forget to use a comma and the word 'and' so that your description makes sense.





Oh no! Someone has not done a very good job of listing three **Did you spot all the mistakes?** adjectives to describe these animals! Can you correct their mistakes?!




