




















Snakes and Ladders

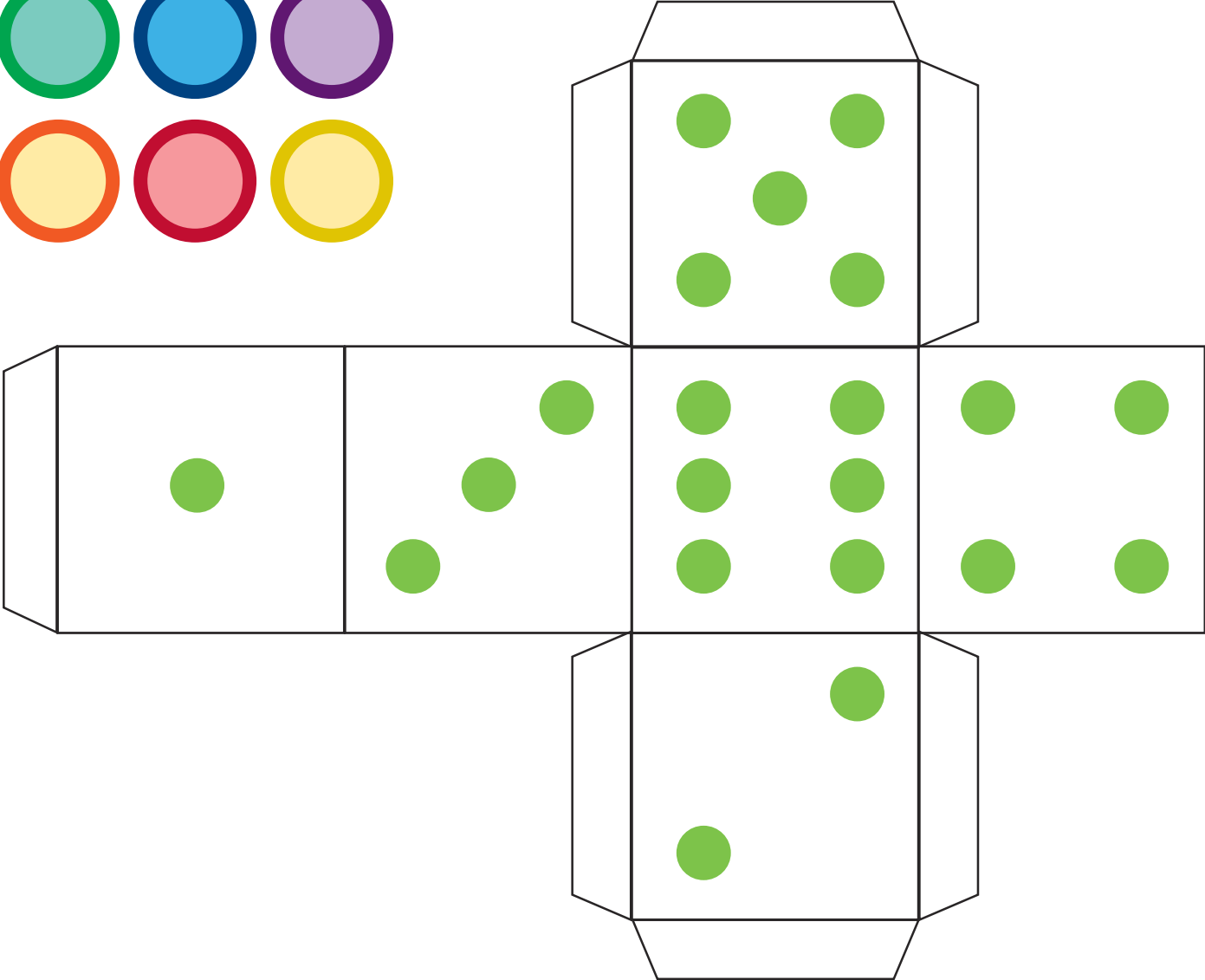
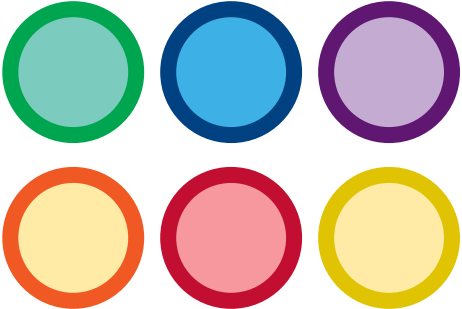
