

The Verb 'to have' (Present Tense)

Affirmative

I You We They	have	got a book.
He She It	has	

Examples

- I have got a book.
- They have got a book.
- You have got a book.
- He has got a book.
- We have got a book.
- She has got a book.
- It has got a book.

Affirmative Contractions

I've You've We've They've	got a book.
He's She's	

Interrogative

Have	I you we they	got a book?
Has	he she	

Examples

- Have I got a book?
- Have they got a book?
- Have you got a book?
- Has he got a book?
- Have we got a book?
- Has she got a book?

Pronouns can also be replaced with proper nouns, such as:

- Tomasz has got a book.
- Jim and Suni have got a book.
- Hannah hasn't got a book.

Negative

I You We They	have not	got a book.
He She	has not	

Examples

- I have not got a book.
- They have not got a book.
- You have not got a book.
- He has not got a book.
- She has not got a book.

Negative Contractions

I You We They	haven't	got a book.
He She	hasn't
