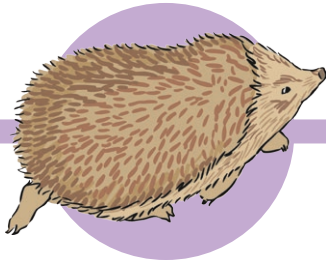

- **Challenge!** Present your evidence to the class at the end of the activity.



The Hodgeheg Activity Cards

Vocabulary

- Using adjectives, write hashtags to describe the main characters in the story. For example, to describe Max: #brightdeterminedhedgehog
- **Challenge!** Write another hashtag to review your feelings about the book, e.g. #excitinghumorousfunbook



Summarise

- Create a telephone answering machine message for Max and his family. Explain why they are out, where they have gone and when they might be home.
- **Challenge!** Act out your answerphone message to a friend. If you had to leave a message after the bleep, what would you say?



Write

- Write a short diary entry in the role of the lollipop lady based on the events of her strange day.
- **Challenge!** Read back through your diary entries. Using a thesaurus, can you up-level three boring words for more ambitious alternatives?



Create

- Create a cartoon strip to summarise the main events in 'The Hodgeheg' using the **Cartoon Strip Activity Sheet**.
- **Challenge!** Write a caption at the bottom of every section to tell the reader of the comic what is happening at each point.
