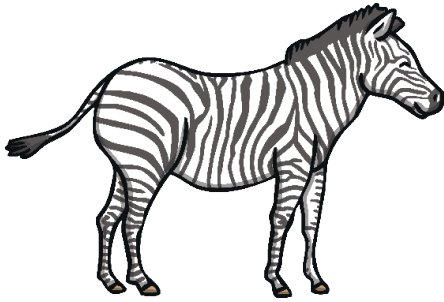


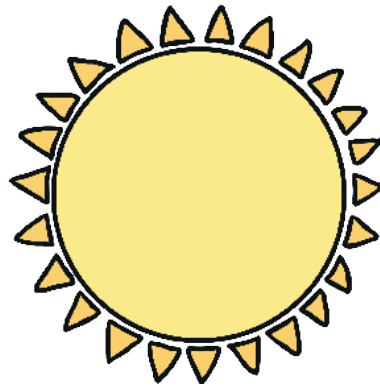
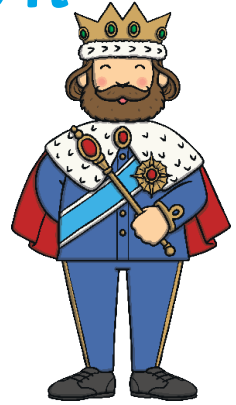
Phoneme

a single sound - can be made using more than one letter

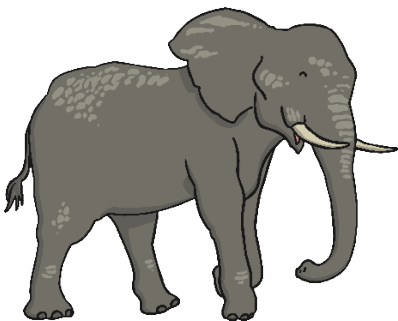
e.g. s, k, z, oo, ph

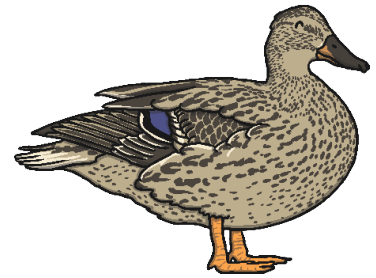

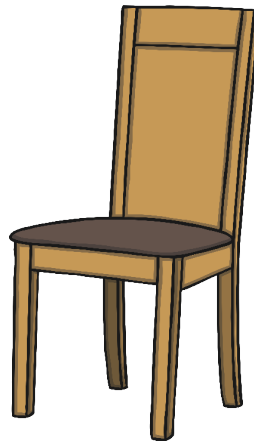
a written sound

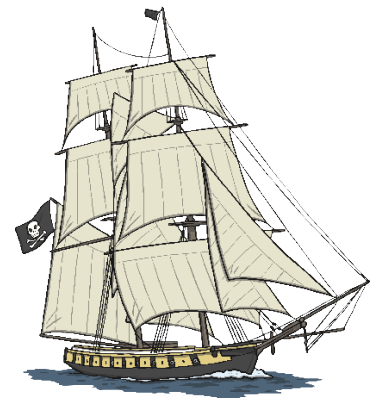

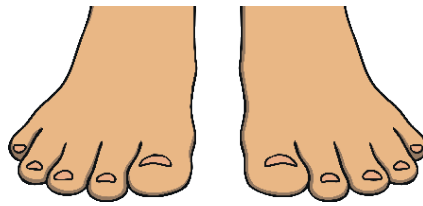
2 letters that make a
