Encourage your child to practise their phonics reading by playing a matching game. Can they use their phonics knowledge to read the words, then show their understanding by choosing the right picture?


How does this help my children's learning?

Phonics is a method used to teach children to learn to read and write by sounding out words by their individual letter sounds, such as sh-e-d.


