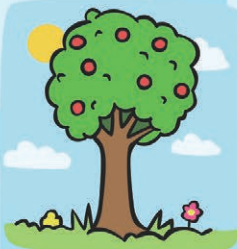

ICT

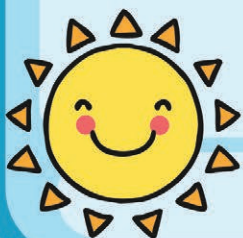
- Research weathers in different countries.
