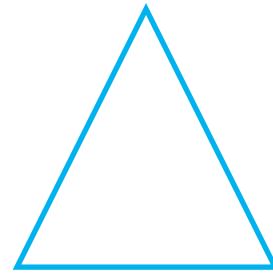


I have three sides.

My sides are straight.

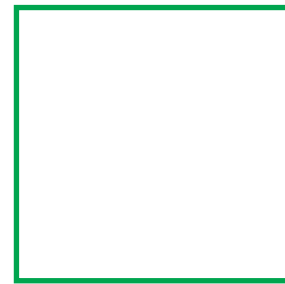
What am I?

and two are short.

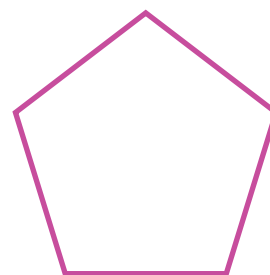
What am I?



rectangle

I have five sides.
I have five corners.
My sides are all straight.

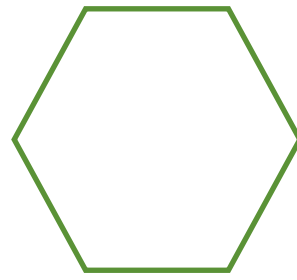
What am I?



pentagon

I have six sides.
I have six corners.
My sides are all straight.

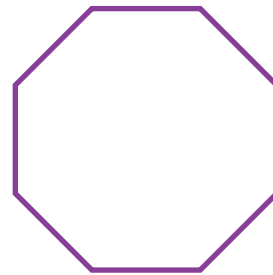
What am I?



hexagon

I have eight sides.
I have eight corners.
My sides are all straight.

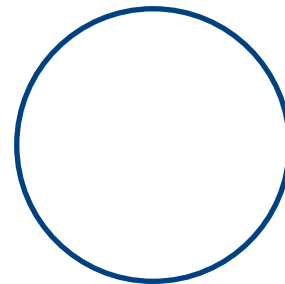
What am I?



octagon

I have one side.
My side is curved.
I have no corners.

What am I?



circle

I have two sides.
I have two corners.
I have one curved side and one straight side.

What am I?

Draw the Shape Instructions

Version 1:

- Cut the cards out and fold them along the dotted line.
- Place the cards with the shapes facing downwards.
- Take it in turns to read the clues on a card.
- Draw the shape using the clues provided.
- Turn over the card to check if you have drawn the correct shape.
- Players earn a point for each correct shape drawn. The player with the most points at the end wins the game.

Version 2:

- This version can be played in pairs.
- Cut the cards out, shuffle them and place them face down.
- Player 1 takes a card and reads the clues.
- Player 2 draws the shape using the clues provided.
- Player 1 reveals the card to Player 2 to check if they have drawn the correct shape.
- Players switch roles.
