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Teaching Suggestions

This set includes one short text with three different questions. To answer the question your students will highlight words in the text and complete a graphic organizer. The text is the same for each question.

In my class, I use the first question as a teacher model, the second as guided practice and the third as independent practice. The third can also be used as a formative assessment. Included is a rubric I use to assess students and provide feedback to the students. I have also included a blank rubric so you can hand write your own requirements on the rubric.

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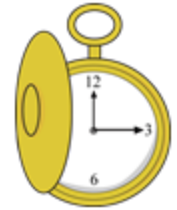

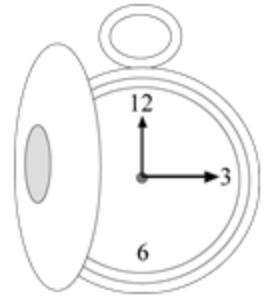
