### INSTRUCTIONS

THIS FREEBIE INCLUDES 3 STORIES LOADED WITH CVC TARGETS. USE THESE STORIES TO ADDRESS CVC SYLLABLE SHAPES AND/OR FINAL CONSONANT DELETION. EACH OF THE STORIES INCLUDES THE 4 COMPONENTS BELOW.

#### Part One:

- Picture grid. This page has images for 9 of the CVC targets that can be found in the story. You can use this page to drill at the word level. You can also use this page as a visual while reading the story. Let your student go on a word hunt and stop you whenever they hear one of the 9 words in the story. Your student can practice the word and mark them off as they hear them.


#### Part Two & Three:

Story & Story Visuals (2 pages). The first page contains the story. The story is loaded with CVC targets. All CVC words are underlined. You can pick and choose the target words you want to use with your student as you read the story. The second page contains images that go along with the story. Let your student follow along with the pictures while you read the story. They can point out all of the CVC words that they see in the pictures. You can ask your student questions throughout the story that will set them up to answer with target word (e.g., "What fell on the parrot's head?" "What did the ram eat?" etc). You also have the option to laminate and cut out the story images. Your student can put them back in order as they retell the story in their own words (Language + Speech!).

#### Part Four:

This page has an image that is related to the story (i.e., net, tin, puddle). After or while reading the story is your student can place different mini objects/erasers onto the images. For example, you can say: "Sam used a net to catch her bird. What else did Sam catch in her net". Let the student place different items onto the net while they say "NET". For the phrase level, your student can say "IN THE NET". For the sentence level, your student can say "THE \_\_\_\_ IS IN THE NET."




















### Sam's Tea Party



























Cam and Jake are going to have a fun race today.
























### Ben's Adventure


