

Impact of daily use of emollient ‘plus’ on corticosteroid consumption in patients with atopic dermatitis: An open randomized controlled study

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daily use of ‘emollient plus’ and bath oils are recommended as baseline therapy to hydrate the skin and maintain the skin barrier.

An open, single-centre randomized controlled study was carried out to **evaluate the benefit of Emollient ‘plus’ balm compared to a commercial classical emollient**

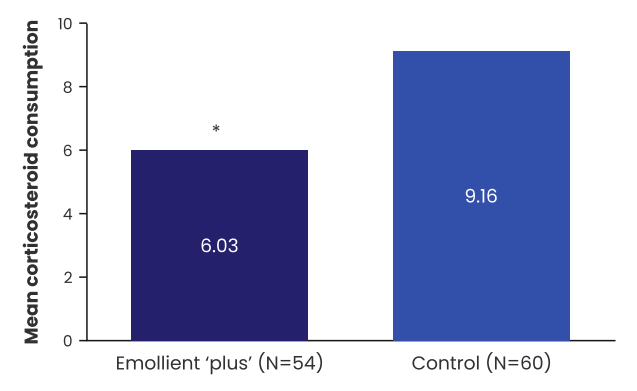


Investigational Product	Emollient Plus , corticosteroids (hydrocortisone 0.1%) to use when necessary
Reference Product	Traditional Emollient , corticosteroids (hydrocortisone 0.1%) to use when necessary
Study Design	An open, single-centre randomized controlled study
Study Objective	To evaluate the benefit of Emollient ‘plus’ balm compared to a commercial classical emollient. <ul style="list-style-type: none">Primary objective: the amount of corticosteroid usedSecondary objective: SCORAD score
No. of Subjects	126 Patients (61 test and 65 control) <ul style="list-style-type: none">Subjects included were male or female patients aged ≥3 years old with mild to moderate AD
Indication	Mild to Moderate AD
Study Duration	28 days

Results:

In the Emollient Plus group:

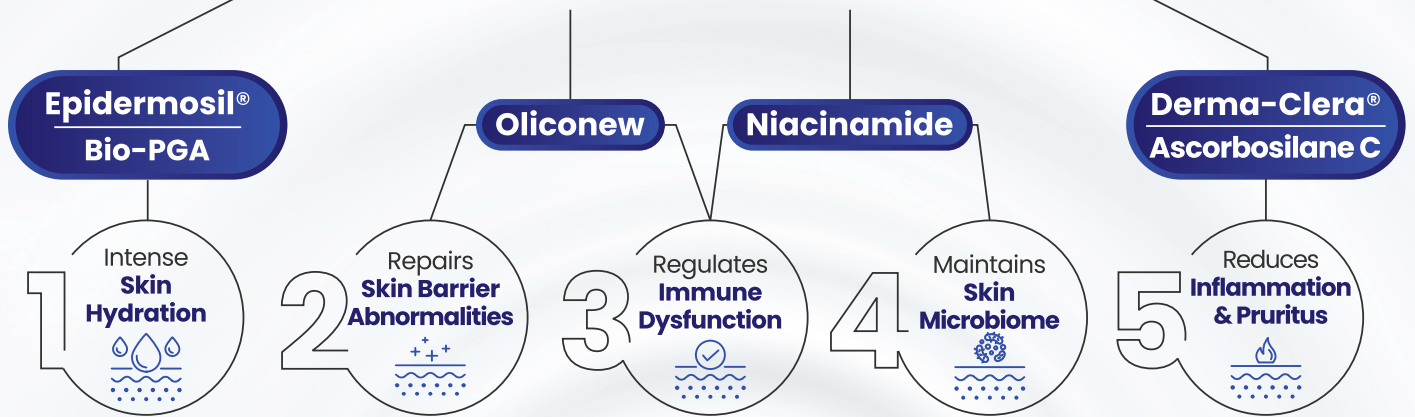
- 31%↓ corticosteroid consumption**
 - Corticosteroid was applied on fewer days (37.5% of days) than in the Control group with fewer applications per day in the Emollient ‘plus’ group.
- 21%↓ in SCORAD score** in just 28 days
