




## DigitalTA project partners participate in a webinar to analyze the first results


### The Ministry of Education of Cantabria in Spain, joins project

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Where are we now?



We are coming to the end of the first year of the Digital TA project, and the work done by all partners is being excellent.

Once finished the development of the state of the art and the pedagogical model that will serve as a basis for the construction of the new Learning Community, we are developing the software that will complement this objective, as well as defining a questionnaire that will allow us to know in depth the professional reality experienced by novice teachers in Europe.

Likewise, and taking advantage of the next face-to-face meeting to be held at the **University of Limerick (UL) from June 5 to 9** of this year, the design of the materials that will allow the proper development of the new platform will begin, as well as the development of the first pilot of the project.
