WHAT TO EXPECT FROM YOUR CHILD?

Remember, every child is special and unique. Some children will show progress immediately, while it may take some time for others to exhibit measurable progress.

Ages 2-3 : 4 to 6 words / stickers every week

Ages 4-5 : 6 to 8 words / stickers every week

Ages 6-7 : 9 to 12 words / stickers every week

The key of learning a new language is "Repeat and Reward" . Always repeat and always reward your children for their progress, even if its just one word. The method or type of reward is up to you; it can be just as simple as giving hugs, kisses or high fives. Or you can turn their reward into a family bonding activity by inviting them to pick out ice-cream, chocolate, or a candy to share, or taking them to a place they enjoy, such as a playground, zoo, park, etc.

You will see the results of your praise and encouragement; they will learn and speak the new language sooner and with enthusiasm.
