Fiscal Impact

The estimated cost for the election services is \$18,000. Funding of \$9,000 is included in the FY20-21 Adopted Budget. Staff is not requesting a budget adjustment at this time due to potential cost savings that may develop to cover all or a portion of additional estimated costs. Staff will review the budget impact later in the fiscal year to determine the need for an adjustment.

Recommendation

It is recommended the Board adopt the Resolution requesting consolidation of the Triunfo Water & Sanitation District General District Election with the November 3, 2020 General Election, and providing for the resolution of a tie vote by Lot; and direct staff to transmit

TRIUNFO WATER & SANITATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. TWSD 2020-005

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE TRIUNFO WATER & SANITATION DISTRICT REQUESTING THAT ITS GENERAL DISTRICT ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020, BE CONSOLIDATED WITH OTHER ELECTIONS CALLED TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DAY AND IN THE SAME TERRITORY

WHEREAS, an election shall be conducted for the Triunfo Water & Sanitation District on November 3, 2020, pursuant to the Uniform District Election Law commencing with Section 10500 of the State of California Elections Code, for the purpose of electing three Directors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors wishes the Elections Division of the Office of the Ventura County Clerk to conduct said election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10400 et seq. of the Elections Code, said election may be consolidated with other elections to be held on the same day; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors desires to request that this District's General District Election be consolidated with any other election which may be held on the same date and involving the same territory; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors acknowledges that the consolidated election will be held and conducted in the manner prescribed in Section 10418; and

WHEREAS, Section 15651 of the Elections Code authorizes the Triunfo Sanitation District to adopt provisions to settle a tie vote by lot involving those candidates who received an equal number of votes and the highest number of votes for an elective office.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TRIUNFO WATER & SANITATION DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the General District Election of this District is to be held on November 3, 2020, and consolidated with any other elections held on the same date and involving all or a portion of the territory of the District pursuant to Section 10400 et seq. of the Elections Code.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That pursuant to Elections Code Section 10002, the District shall reimburse the County in full for the services performed upon presentation of an invoice to the District.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That pursuant to Section 15651 of the Elections Code of the State of California, if any two or more persons receive an equal and the highest number of votes

for an office to be voted for within the Triunfo Water & Sanitation District, a tie vote shall be resolved by lot.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That the resolution shall apply only to the election to be held on November 8, 2016, and shall then be repealed.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. The Clerk of the District's Board of Directors shall immediately file a copy of this Resolution with the office of the Ventura County Clerk.
