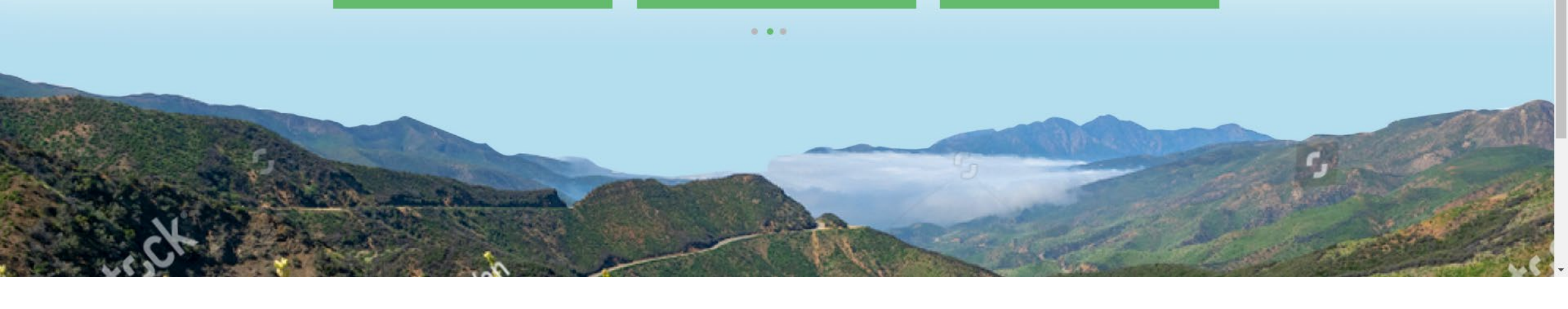

Our History



The Beginning

Triunfo Sanitation District was organized November 12, 1963, pursuant to [California Health and Safety Code Division 5, Part 3, Chapter 3, Section 4700](#), as a special district to provide sewer services for the eastern portion of Ventura County.

A year later, Triunfo and Las Virgenes Municipal Water District established a Joint Powers Authority (JPA) to construct, operate and maintain a regional sewage collection and treatment system to serve customers within their respective service areas. The system also includes production and distribution of recycled water.

Current Operations

In 1993, Triunfo expanded its operations to include potable water service with the purchase of the Metropolitan Water Company, located within the District's service area in Oak Park. The new venture became known as Oak Park Water Service. On July 1, 2019, Triunfo added "water" to its name and integrated the operations of Oak Park Water Service into the single entity of Triunfo Water & Sanitation District.

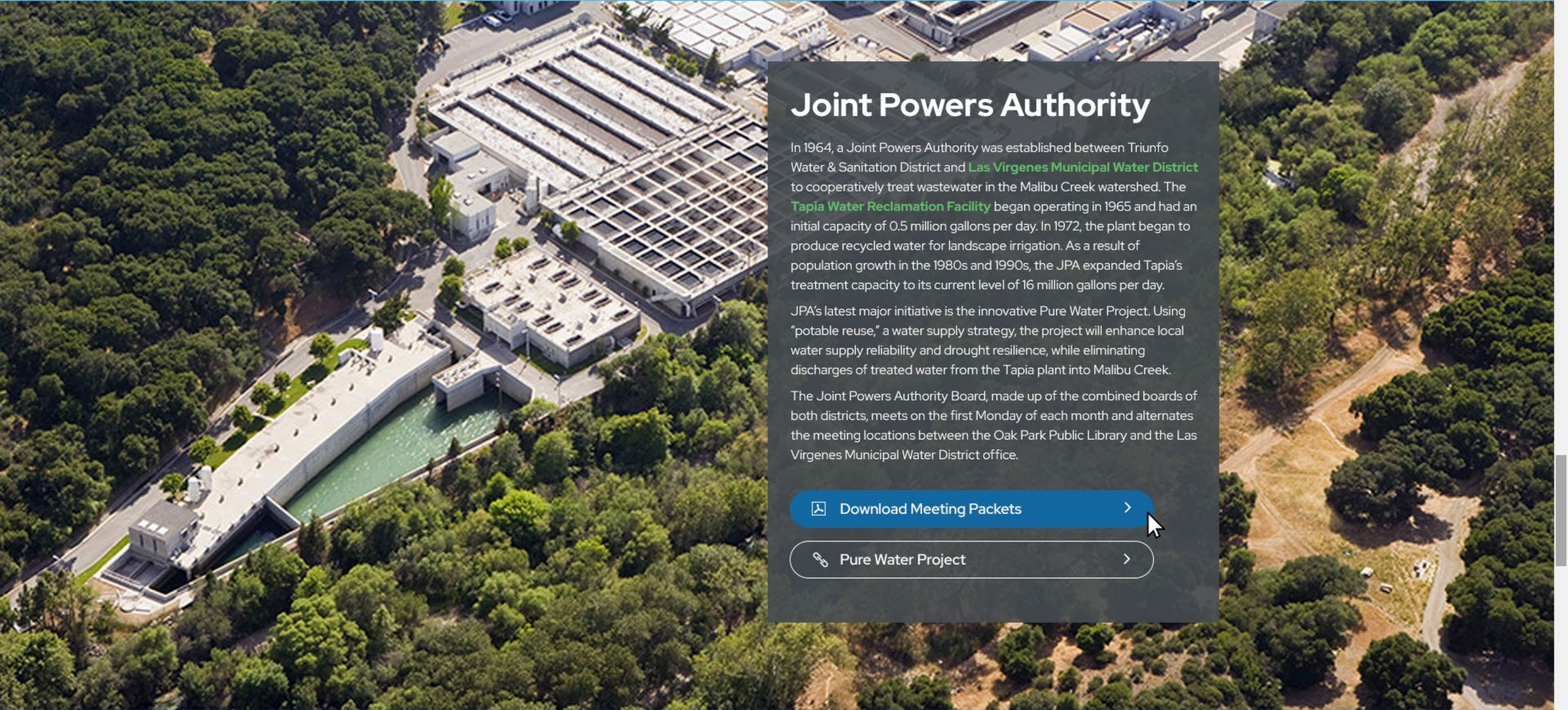


Rates for Service

The rates for sewer, potable water, and recycled water services are shown below. **For more information, download the ordinance(s) below.**

Sewer service rates appear on customers' property tax bills. The Board approved a 5-year plan, which increases the monthly sewer rates effective July 1 of each year from 2015 to 2020. Rates for the most common customer categories are shown below for July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020.

Joint Powers Authority

In 1964, a Joint Powers Authority was established between Triunfo Water & Sanitation District and **Las Virgenes Municipal Water District** to cooperatively treat wastewater in the Malibu Creek watershed. The **Tapia Water Reclamation Facility** began operating in 1965 and had an initial capacity of 0.5 million gallons per day. In 1972, the plant began to produce recycled water for landscape irrigation. As a result of population growth in the 1980s and 1990s, the JPA expanded Tapia's treatment capacity to its current level of 16 million gallons per day.

JPA's latest major initiative is the innovative Pure Water Project. Using "potable reuse," a water supply strategy, the project will enhance local water supply reliability and drought resilience, while eliminating discharges of treated water from the Tapia plant into Malibu Creek.

The Joint Powers Authority Board, made up of the combined boards of both districts, meets on the first Monday of each month and alternates the meeting locations between the Oak Park Public Library and the Las Virgenes Municipal Water District office.
