**SUBJECT: Kimball Park Basketball Court Mural Design** 


**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends Public Art Committee members review and approve the art design for Kimball Park Basketball Court Mural.

**BOARD/COMMISSION PRIOR ACTION:** None

**STATEMENT ON SUBJECT**: ARTS has developed a concept for a basketball court mural at Kimball Park. ARTS staff have been working with students in local schools to develop the art designs. The students are from Sweetwater High School, National Middle School, Granger Middle School, and other local schools. The overall project involves the repair, resurfacing, and painted design work for the basketball court mural.

ARTS staff is presenting its design for the review and approval of the Public Art Committee. If approved, City Council will also review the design and agreement for the project at a September meeting. The mural design is attached and is called "Convergence." This rendering captures the proposed overall design and the color palette. The animating concept of the design is the convergence of parkland and the bay beyond, with the creek in the middle. This also captures the specific geography of the basketball court.

ARTS will work with a subcontractor to repair and resurface the court according to City specifications as part of the project. ARTS will also maintain the basketball court design for five years.
