3. **Consider the approval of the Minutes** of the December 13, 2022, regular meeting of the Texas Transportation Commission
4. **Acknowledgement of Service**
Recognize the service of Texas Transportation Commissioner Laura Ryan for 12 years of state service.
5. **Contracts**
Consider the award or rejection of contracts for highway construction and maintenance, and construction and rehabilitation of buildings, and consider the approval of an increase in funds for certain highway construction projects that received bids with cost overruns. (Presentation)
These proposed minute orders contain information concerning the receipt of bids for highway improvement contracts and may include a proposal to increase funds from categories 2, 4 and/or 12 for certain projects. The department may reschedule receipt of bids for those projects where the commission rejects all bids or reassess funding proposals. Those bids and funding increases accepted by the commission will result in conditional contract awards to the low bidders. Contract award conditions may involve securing funding from other sources, the contractor's ability to satisfy federal DBE subcontracting requirements, or other requirements as outlined in the project bid proposal.

Rescind award of and reject BRAZORIA COUNTY Project BR 2013(874), previously awarded August 31, 2021, by Minute Order 116070 (see attached itemized list) (MO). It is necessary to rescind the previous award of BRAZORIA COUNTY Project BR 2013(874) and reject all bids on the respective project in the best interest of the state.

6. **Discussion Item**
Development of the 2024 Unified Transportation Program (UTP) planning targets (Presentation)
The Unified Transportation Program (UTP) is a 10-year statewide plan for transportation project development. The purpose of this presentation is to facilitate a discussion of the 2024 UTP planning targets and investment strategy. The outcome will be a guidance document to be distributed to department districts, metropolitan planning organizations, and other planning partners for the development of the 2024 UTP.

7. **Texas Delivers 2050 - Freight Mobility Plan**
Consider the adoption of Texas Delivers 2050 (MO)
This minute order adopts Texas Delivers 2050 as the department's current freight mobility plan. Texas Delivers 2050 fulfills the requirements of the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act to develop a performance-based, statewide, multimodal freight plan and serves as an update to the previous plan, which was adopted in March of 2018.

8. **Public Transportation**
Various Counties - Consider the award of federal §5311 formula grant program funds to multiple entities for a variety of program-eligible purposes (MO)
The awards identified in this minute order reflect distribution of the remaining balance of Fiscal Year 2022 §5311 funds and prior year funding available for award to rural transit districts.

9. **Promulgation of Administrative Rules** Under Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, and the Administrative Procedure Act, Government Code, Chapter 2001:
Rule Review
Consider readoption of Title 43 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 10, Ethical Conduct by Entities Doing Business with the Department, and Chapter 16, Planning and Development of Transportation Projects, in accordance with Government Code, §2001.039 (MO)
State law requires a state agency to review each of its rules every four years. After review, the agency must readopt the rule, readopt the rule with amendments, or repeal the rule. The department reviews its rules on a rotating basis.

10. **State Infrastructure Bank** (Presentation)
Cherokee County - West Jacksonville Water Supply Corporation - Consider final approval of a request from West Jacksonville Water Supply Corporation for a State Infrastructure Bank loan in the amount of up to \$699,000 to pay for the costs of utility relocation necessary for a non-tolled state highway improvement project to widen US 175 in Cherokee County, Texas (MO)
West Jacksonville Water Supply Corporation (WSC) will secure the loan with a pledge of contract revenues and water revenues. The loan will be used to pay the WSC's costs associated with the utility relocation necessary for a non-tolled state highway improvement project to widen US 175 in Cherokee County, Texas.

11. **Eminent Domain Proceedings**

Various Counties - Consider the authorization of the filing of condemnation proceedings to acquire real property by eminent domain for non-controlled and controlled access highways (see attached itemized list) (MO)

Commission findings, determinations, and authorizations for the state, by motion made in accordance with Senate Bill 18, 82nd Legislature, to acquire by eminent domain, upon the payment of adequate and just compensation, various ownership interests in specific parcels of real property that are needed to develop or improve both non-controlled and controlled access state highways, to include requesting the state attorney general to bring and pursue condemnation suits relating to those specific parcels of real property described in the attached itemized list.

12. **Routine Minute Orders and Reports**

a. **Donations to the Department**

Various Counties - Consider the acknowledgment of donations with a value of \$500 or more, including donations of money, materials, services, or real property, that are made to the department for the purpose of assisting the department in carrying out its functions and duties or for improving access to or from a highway on the state highway system (see attached itemized list) (MO)

State statutes require the commission to acknowledge the acceptance of a gift to the department that is valued at \$500 or more. By the adoption of this minute order, the commission acknowledges the receipt and acceptance of the property specified in the minute order.

b. **Real Estate Dispositions**

The commission must approve the sales, transfers, and exchanges of state rights of way and other real properties that are no longer needed for a state highway purpose. It must also approve, accept, and acknowledge donations to the state of real property that is valued at \$500 or more.

(1) **Austin County** - Loop 497 - Consider the quitclaim of any interest that might have accrued to the state by use of former right of way to Austin County, Texas (MO)

The district has determined that a segment of roadway is no longer needed as part of the system. This property was acquired and held by Austin County in its own name for use by the state, and the county has requested a quitclaim of any interest that might have accrued to the state by use.

(2) **Brazos County** - FM 2223 - Consider an easement release to the underlying fee owner (MO)

The district has determined that the easement is no longer needed for highway purposes. The easement may be released to the underlying fee owner.

(3) **Brazos County** - FM 2223 - Consider an easement release to the underlying fee owner (MO)

The district has determined that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes. An abutting landowner has requested to purchase the land, and it may be sold to the requester.

- (7) **Tarrant County** - on Trinity Boulevard near FM 157 - Consider the sale of right of way to the Trinity River Authority of Texas (MO)

The district has determined that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes. The Trinity River Authority of Texas has requested to purchase the land, and it may be sold to the Trinity River Authority of Texas

c. **Reports**

(1) **Compliance Division Report**

State law requires the commission to establish a compliance program, which must include a Compliance Division to oversee the program. The Compliance Division is responsible for acting to prevent and detect serious breaches of department policy, fraud, waste, and abuse of office, including any acts of criminal conduct within the department. The Compliance Division is required to provide a monthly report to the commission regarding investigations and a summary of information relating to trends and recommendations.

(2) **Letting Allocation Status Report**

Quarterly status report on the FY 2023 letting allocation, the actual allocation utilized through the current month, and proposed remaining highway maintenance and construction contract letting for the fiscal year (Report)

This report will provide the current overall allocation status, by district, metropolitan planning organization, and statewide program, of the FY 2023 letting allocation and will also provide the anticipated effect on the letting allocation of remaining proposed highway maintenance and construction letting.

(3) **Quarterly Cash Report**

Quarterly report on FY 2023 State Highway Fund 6 cash status (Report)

This report updates the commission on the year-to-date cash balance and activity of State Highway Fund 6. The report will include original projections and actual revenues/inflows and expenditures/outflows on a cash basis.

(4) **Annual Financial Report**

Texas Department of Transportation Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (with Independent Auditor's Report) for the Fiscal Year Ended August 31, 2022 (Report)

State law requires that a state agency prepare an annual financial report regarding the agency's use of appropriated money during the preceding fiscal year. In addition, the department is required to have an independent certified public accountant audit the department's books and accounts for each toll project or system at least annually.

(5) **Texas Mobility Fund**

Audited financial statements of the Texas Mobility Fund as required by the governing master resolution (Report)

The master resolution governing the issuance of Texas Mobility Fund (TMF) bonds requires the preparation of an audited financial report of the TMF for each fiscal year. Audited financial statements have been prepared for FY2022.

(6) **Central Texas Turnpike System**

Travis and Williamson Counties- Audited financial statements of the Central Texas Turnpike System (CTTS), as required by the CTTS Indenture of Trust (Report)

The Indenture of Trust (Indenture) that prescribes the terms for bonds and obligations issued to finance the 2002 Project of the Central Texas Turnpike System, a toll project comprised of the SH130, Segments 1-4, SH45N, SH45SE, and Loop 1 project elements, requires the preparation of a financial report of the results of operation of the system for each fiscal year. Audited financial statements meeting the requirements of the Indenture have been prepared for FY2022.

d. **Land Acquisitions for Facilities**

Various Counties - Consider the grant of authority to the department to acquire real property for facilities (MO)

The department is in the process of acquiring real property for the construction of new facilities and the expansion of existing facility sites. Funds for the purchase of these properties were appropriated by the 87th Legislature, Supplemental Appropriations Act for the 2022-23 Biennium. The department requests the commission's authorization to enter into purchase contracts and related documents to complete the acquisition of the listed properties.

e. **Speed Zones**

Various Counties - Consider the establishment or alteration of regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state (MO)

This minute order establishes or alters regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state.

13. **Executive Session** Pursuant to Government Code, Chapter 551

Section 551.071 - Consultation with and advice from legal counsel regarding any item on this agenda, pending or contemplated litigation, or other legal matters.
