WE FEEL OUR BIGGEST STRENGTH IS COMMUNICATION. We never do anything major without discussing and agreeing to how it will be done.

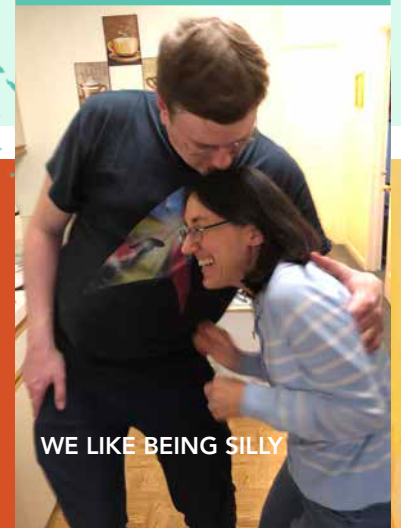
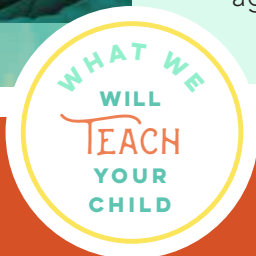
