4.1. CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES:

Closing date for entries: 24 September 2021 (Friday) at 18:00.

4.2. ENTRY PROCEDURE:

Competitors may enter the event using the on-line entry system which can be accessed via www.autorally.lt until closing date of entries specified in 4.1. Entries are only accepted if accompanied by the total amount of entry fee.

Fully filled and signed entry form must be provided to the Organiser during Administrative Checks.

Co-driver details may be specified during the Administrative Check.

Note: in order to speed up procedures and avoid people concentration at Administrative checking Competitors are asked to send scanned documents - Driver and Co-driver competition licences; Driver and Co-driver valid driving licences; ASN authorisation (where applicable); Medical certificate of aptitude – via e-mail zarasai.rally@gmail.com .

4.3. NUMBER OF COMPETITORS ACCEPTED AND CLASSES:

4.3.1 Maximum number. The maximum number of entries accepted will be 110. If more than 110 entries are received, the Organiser reserves the sole right to decide which entries will be accepted. Maximum number of Shakedown entries – 50.

Competitors who wish to receive Invoices for entry fees and additional space in Service Park must fill in the information on the entry form. **Invoices will be sent by email.**

“0” crews willing to participate in rally, must pay a 250 EUR deposit until 24 September (Monday) 18:00 (details for bank transfer are provided in 4.5. article). The mentioned deposit is returned in that case, if the crew has performed a qualitative run during the rally and has fulfilled the tasks and functions trusted to the crew.

Winner of 2020 year LARSC classifications and Junior class, **who have never before participated in LARC classification**, can take a part in LARC with a fee 250 EUR. Driver and co-driver are considered as winners if they take first place in any of LARSC classification. In case if those driver and co-driver are starting in 2021 year LARC being a part of separate crews, the smaller entry fee applies towards both crews. For winner of Junior classification, decreased entry fee is applicable only for the 1st driver, it means, hid / hers crew.

For 2020 year LMRC classifications winners participating in LARSC or any event of LARSC, the entry fee 125 EUR. Winners are 1st and 2nd drivers, who won the 1st place on any of the LMRC classifications. In case if these 2020 year winners start in LARSC (1st and 2nd drivers) different crews, entry fees must be decreased for both crews they are the part of.

4.6. REFUNDS:

V. INSURANCE

5.1. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE ORGANISER:

5.1.1. Organiser’s Liability Insurance

Organiser has concluded an insurance contract with Organiser’s liability insurance covering damage caused to a third party during the competition up to 58000 EUR.

5.1.2. Damage Caused to the Third Party

A part of insurance contract is coverage for damages caused to the third party. However, damages caused by drivers among themselves are not covered by contract.

5.1.3. International Green Card

All crews at Administrative Check have to hand in a valid motor third party liability insurance policy or International Green card for their car. Without these cards, the crew will not be permitted to start.

5.2. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR COMPETITORS AND CREWS:

All drivers and co-drivers are obliged to arrange their own life accident insurance. The proof should be documented on request at administrative checking.

By the fact of signing entry form, competitors and/or drivers relinquish any claims to compensation of any kind which might result due to incidents. The relinquishment is applied to FIA, ASN and Organiser, officials and other competitors and/or drivers. Drivers and co-drivers from non-EU countries have to have valid travel insurance contracts with active recreational risks included.

5.3. DAMAGE REPORTING:

Crews are obliged to notify Organiser about any damage caused on track by their car by the end of event the latest. Violation of this duty will be penalized by 100 EUR.

5.4. INSURANCE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS:

Auxiliary vehicles, reconnaissance cars and vehicles with special stickers issued by the organiser are not covered by the provided rally insurance (with the exception of insured Organiser's cars) and those are always going on their own responsibility.

5.5. DAMAGE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS:

The Organiser refuses any liability for damage that has been caused by a participant due to unfair action – either regarding rally regulations or these Supplementary Regulations or the State Law. In case of a road traffic accident neither a service car, reconnaissance car nor official's car with rally markings are considered as crew of the competition. In these cases, only a car owner third-person liability insurance policies are valid.

VI. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING:

Prior to the pre-start scrutineering starting numbers, rally plates and Organiser's advertising should be affixed on the rally car according to Appendix 4.

6.2. LOSS OR REMOVAL OF COMPETITION NUMERS AND ADVERTISING:

Failure to comply with any regulations concerning the plates and identification numbers will be sanctioned as follows:

- One missing Rally Plate or Competition Number: cash penalty of 100 EUR;
- Competition Numbers or Rally Plates are missing at the same time: reported to the Stewards;
- Rally Plates failing to be visible or partially covering license plate: cash penalty of 100 EUR;

VII. TYRES

7.1. NUMBER OF TYRES AND ELIGIBLE TYRES:

7.1.1. Number of tyres. The number of tyres for the competition is 12. Tyres used during the shakedown and city stage (SS4/5) will not be counted towards the maximum number of tyres used during event.

7.1.2. Eligible tyres for LARC. For all Lithuanian Rally Championship Competitors tyres must comply with Appendix 13 of LARC Regulations 2021. Gravel tyres can be used only.

7.1.3. Eligible tyres for LRC. For all Latvian Rally Championship Competitors tyres must comply with Art.60 of Latvian Rally Regulations.

7.2. TYRES USED FOR RECONNAISSANCE:

Only E- or DOT-approved road homologated tyres are allowed. Retreated tyres are forbidden for reconnaissance. Any treatment (i.e. Removing or damaging) on road tyres side markings or texts is not allowed.

VIII. FUEL

8.1. FUEL RESTRICTIONS:

E85 fuel (bioethanol), which is commercially available at retail dealers, is permitted.

8.2. REFUELLING:

8.2.1. All Competitors may only refuel in a Refuelling Zone (RZ) and Remote Refuelling Zone (RRZ). There will be a Refuelling Zone marked in the Road Book after the exit TC from the Regrouping area in Zarasai, Remote Refuelling Zone in Daugailiai during section 4 of the rally and Remote Refuelling Zone in Degučiai during section 6 of the rally.

8.2.2. Refuelling at the exit of the Service Park and at RRZ. Competitors' cars may be refueled from drums/cans with commercially available fuel and two team members with team passes may access the RZ to assist each crew.

8.2.3. Refuelling procedure. Only crew members and support personnel are responsible for compliance with fire safety regulations during the refueling. Liquid proof mat has to be used. Penalty for non-compliance is 50 EUR.

IX. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1. PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION:

Reconnaissance registration will take place at the same time with administrative checks as follows:

30 September 2021 (Thursday) 8:00–12:00;

9.1.1. Checking of Reconnaissance cars

Reconnaissance cars will be checked during reconnaissance. Reconnaissance cars must comply with Art.35.1 of T-2021. If, for any reason, a crew is forced to replace the reconnaissance car during the reconnaissance, the Clerk of the Course (phone: +370 614 81141) must be informed about the details of the new reconnaissance car.

9.2. NATIONAL SPEED LIMITS:

Town/Village 50 km/h

Non residence:

Gravel roads: 70 km/h

Asphalt roads: 90 km/h

Motorways: 120 km/h

Highways: 130 km/h

9.2.1. Speed during reconnaissance

All reconnaissance of Special Stages has to be done at reasonable speed in accordance with Lithuanian traffic rules. The maximum speed set for reconnaissance of SS is 80 km/h, except for those areas in which there are speed limit signs (50 km/h or 30km/h) or other limitations marked in the Road Book. Breaking the rules and exceeding speed limits on public roads will be also controlled and fined by the Lithuanian Police according to traffic laws of Lithuania. **GPS data will also be monitored during liaison.**

9.3. GPS SPEED CONTROL CHECKING DEVICES:

9.3.1. Collection of GPS speed control checking devices

9.3.2. Rally Safety Tracking system

Organiser will provide a rally safety tracking system, which has to be used during reconnaissance in the reconnaissance car. If the system will not be used, it is a breach of the reconnaissance regulations. The progress of reconnaissance will be monitored via GPS system by rally officials. GPS data will be monitored also during liaisons. Evaluation of GPS data is within competence of Clerk of the Course. If reconnaissance vehicle is not equipped with a working tracking device, the crew will be penalized by Stewards. After reconnaissance, crews have to re-install the tracking device to the rally car.

Returning of tracking device after TC 14 to Rally HQ until 02 October 2021 (Saturday) 21:00 at the latest.

9.3.3. Principles on Security and Tracking

Security and tracking devices are connected to a monitoring centre that stores all data received. All data is stored on the same device. The device has a self-contained power supply that operates throughout the rally. The device has „SOS“ and „OK“ buttons.

Each device has a unique serial number that is assigned to each crew. During the event the Rally HQ will monitor the position and speed data of each crew.

By pressing a “SOS” button a crew reports an accident and requests an immediate assistance. In this case, it is obligatory to inform the Rally HQ by calling the telephone number indicated on the label. In case of an accident or technical problem during a Special Stage, by pressing an “OK” button a crew informs of a stop for more than 30 seconds and that immediate assistance is not required (even if a crew is trying to continue the rally).

Attention! In case of stopping at a Special Stage the device sends a “SOS” signal and the crew within 30 seconds must press “OK” button to remove the “SOS” signal sent by the system. A mobile phone of the crew must be switched on (or turned on in 60 seconds) so that the Race Control Centre could reach the crew.

Wrong “SOS” and/or “OK” signal transmission will be reported to the Stewards who may apply a penalty.

9.4. RECONNAISSANCE TIME SCHEDULE:

Reconnaissance time schedule is given in Appendix 2.

9.5. RECONNAISSANCE RULES:

Reconnaissance will be organized in compliance with Art.35 of T-2021 and these Regulations.

9.5.1 Restriction of reconnaissance

Any driver, or co-driver, or any other team member who has entered or intends to enter the rally and who wishes to drive on any road which is or might be used as a Special Stage in the rally after publication of Supplementary Regulations, may only do so after he has obtained the written permission from the Organiser. This shall not apply when the person is known to live along the specific road. Failure to respect this rule shall result in driver being reported to the Stewards.

9.5.2. Number of persons on board During each passage through a Special Stage, a maximum of 2 persons are permitted in the car. 3rd person may drive in the car during reconnaissance only with the permit from the Clerk of the Course and has to have a valid annual drivers license issued by LASF or other ASN.

9.5.3. Number of passages

A maximum 2 passages over each Special Stages is permitted during reconnaissance. Special Stages run twice are considered to be one Special Stage.

9.5.4. Speeding

Speeding will be penalized according Art.34.2.2 of T-2021.

X. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1. DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED:

At Administrative Checks the following documents will be checked and entry form details verified:

- Competitor's licence;
- Driver and Co-driver competition licences;
- Driver and Co-driver valid driving licences;
- ASN authorisation (where applicable);
- Completion of all details on the entry form;
- Medical certificate of aptitude (F 068/a or „Medical certificate of aptitude“ FIA ISC, appendix L, cause 1.8);
- Valid personal accident insurance of non-EU drivers

If afore mentioned documents have been sent to the organiser via e-mail – zarasai.rally@gmail.com – they will not be checked once again. However, competitors will be asked to show their licenses and present the originally signed entry form. In order to speed up procedures and avoid people concentration competitors are asked to book a time for administrative checking on www.autorally.lt.

10.2. TIMETABLE:

Administrative checks will take place at the same time with Reconnaissance registration as follows:

30 September 2021 (Thursday) 8:00–12:00;

XI. SCRUTINEERING, MARKING AND SEALING

11.1. LOCATION AND SCHEDULE:

30 September 2021 (Thursday) 11:00–20:00

Location: Parking lot on Savanorių str., Zarasai; GPS: 55.7330, 26.2473

Participants may request the suitable scrutineering time during on-line registration at www.autorally.lt. **However, organiser reserves the sole right to move the scrutineering time in attempt to make scrutineering as efficient as possible. The detailed timetable for pre-rally scrutineering will be published in a Bulletin.**

Any crew taking part in the rally, or their representative must arrive at the Scrutineering and present the car in accordance with the timetable to be issued in a Bulletin. **Any lateness entering to pre-rally Scrutineering area will be fined by 30 EUR for each 10 minutes delayed.** Driver and Co-driver are not required to be present during Scrutineering.

Documents to be presented during Scrutineering:

- Valid vehicle insurance policy (“Green card”);
- Vehicle registration documents;
- Vehicle FIA technical passport, when it's applicable;
- Vehicle ASN technical passport, when it's applicable;
- Fully and correctly filled Safety Equipment declaration (must be fulfilled on www.autorally.lt);

11.2. MUDGUARDS:

Transversal mudguards are not mandatory.

11.3. WINDOWS:

The use of silvered or tinted films is authorized on side windows and rear windows only (in conformity with Appendix J Article 253-11)

11.4. DRIVERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT

During scrutineering all items of protective clothing are going to be checked, including underwear, helmets and FIA approved head restraint (FHR). Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked.

11.5. NOISE LEVEL:

The maximum noise level must not exceed 103 dB for an engine rotation speed of 3500 rpm.

11.6. INSTALATION OF SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM:

11.6.1. All Competitors must make provision in their cars for the installation of the Safety Tracking System. Systems will be issued at the Administrative Checks. All further details will be given during presentation to each crew.

11.6.2. Competitors must have installed the speed control and safety tracking devices in reconnaissance cars before reconnaissance starts. The system must be re-installed to the rally cars by the crews and must be shown to the Scrutineers before the start of Shakedown or before the start of Leg1 at TC0 in the Service Zone.

11.6.3. Any attempt to tamper with, to manipulate or to interfere with the tracking device fitted to the competition car or any device that fails to record a trace due to external interference will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty up to exclusion.

XII. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1. CEREMONIAL START PROCEDURE AND ORDER:

The Rally starts at TC 0. All crews will start from the Service Zone respecting the times published in the starting order – pre-start area will not be held.

12.2. FINISH PROCEDURE:

After the final Special Stage all crews will continue to Park Fermé at Sèliq sq.

The finish of the rally will be at TC 14A. GPS tracking device is allowed to be removed from sport car in Park Ferme. Final scrutineering for optionally chosen cars will be held in Park Ferme. In case of a technical protest cars will be delivered to final check after the finish podium.

Cars can be taken from Park Ferme only with permission of Stewards. If the competition will follow the planned schedule properly Park Ferme is planned to be closed at 21:00.

12.3. PERMITTED EARLY CHECK-IN:

Crews are authorised to check-in early without time penalty at:

- TC 5B (entering the Park Fermé);
- TC 9A (entering the Service Park);
- TC 14A (entering the Park Fermé).

12.4. START PROCEDURE FOR SPECIAL STAGES:

Start procedure for special Stages will be as follows:

- On the start position crew stops when instructed by marshals;
- When the start marshal confirms that the car is on the right start position – 40 cm before electronically controlled start line the car must stay immovable till start moment and the crew must visually follow the time and lights on the monitor.
- 30 seconds before start marshal hands the Time Card to Co-driver;
- The last five seconds are marked by 5 red lights and a green light. The first red light lights up on 55th second, second – on 56th second and so on. On the time of exact minute red light go out and green light lights up.
- If the car crosses the beam before the green light lights up "FALSE" will be shown automatically on the monitor. False-start will be penalized according T-2021 Art.48.6.
- The start marshal makes the final decision about false-start and notes this in the start report.
- In case of start system malfunction the start will be given by marshals according to T-2021 Art.48.3.

Upon retiring, a crew must hand in its time card either to a marshal at a TC or to the sweeping car.

12.6. OFFICIAL TIME USED DURING THE RALLY:

During all rally, official time is considered the Eastern European summer time (CET +2, UTC+3).

12.7. REGROUPING:

There are two regroupings for LARC competitors according to results on SS 1-5 and SS 1-9 for all competitors. Crews will get new start times for TC 5C.

There is one regrouping for LARSC competitors according to results on SS 1-2 for all competitors. Crews will get new start times for TC 9C.

12.8. RETIRING BECAUSE OF AN ACCIDENT:

Retiring Competitors of LARC after an accident must submit their cars to the Chief Scrutineer Saulius Stanaitis +370 687 31023 for inspection of damage. Failure to do so will result in fines.

Service regulations will be in accordance with T-2021.

Service Park is located on Sėlių sq., Zarasai. Surface: tarmac.

Service Park opens on 30 September (Thursday) 10:30 and closes on 02 October 2021 (Saturday) 22:00.

Traffic for Zarasai residents will be restricted from 01 October (Friday) 2021 7:30 .

12.9.1. Service areas will be allocated by Organizer according to information uploaded in e-application. Each competition car will be given the following area free of charge: LARC – up to **50 m²**; LARSC – up to **50 m²**; LRC – up to **50 m²**;

Competitors may order additional service space marked in „Location of Service Park areas“ to be published on www.rallyaukstaitija.lt, www.autorally.lt . Closing date for service area reservations 24 September (Friday) 2021 18:00. After missing this term, area will be assigned by Organizers decision. If applicant has several cars participating in competition which has common service, request for merged service must reach the organizer until 24 September (Friday) 18:00.

12.9.2. In Service Park, all crews are obliged to have a liquid-proof tarp of minimum 3x5m under competition cars. Drilling or any other damages to the surface of the Service Park have to be avoided. Teams must bring weights for fixing their tents. Each Competitor is liable for the damages to the Service Zone allocated to them. After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition. The crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage.

12.9.3. Only one service vehicle without trailer per one competitor is allowed in Service Park. Vehicles must be clearly identified by a “Service” sticker issued by the Organiser and affixed on the windscreen. Recce and team representative vehicles are not allowed to enter Service Parks. **Please, leave Your trailers in areas specified by the Organiser – Statybininkų str. 2, Zarasai; GPS: 55.716989, 26.248054.**

12.9.4. Competitors who fail to comply with Service Park rules are subject to a penalty starting from 50 EUR up to exclusion.

12.10. SHAKEDOWN:

Shakedown will be held 01 October (Friday) 2021 10:00 – 12:00. There will be maximum 2 passes through Shakedown. Total distance of Shakedown – 3,52 km.

Willing to participate in Shakedown must indicate this on entry form uploaded on www.autorally.lt but no later than 24 September (Friday) 2021 18:00. Entry fee for Shakedown 100 Eur.

Maximum number of participants 50, therefore registration might be stopped earlier. Entry fee is non-refundable if registered entry will not participate. Except Force Majeure cases.

Pre- start scrutineering must be passed through for cars participating in Shakedown. Start numbers, rally and advertisement stickers provided by Organizers must be stucked to cars. GPS tracking system must be installed.

Any other person as second driver in the cars who is not a rally participant, must sign a form provided by Organizer for assuming the responsibility.

During the Shakedown all persons inside the car must wear helmets meeting the safety requirements as well as clothes and other safety equipment.

12.11. CHICANES:

Due to safety reasons, chicanes will be positioned on the rally route to reduce speed of rally cars. For the duration of Reconnaissance, if possible the Chicanes will be positioned on the spots where they will stand also during the rally. On the spots where positioning of chicanes for the duration of Reconnaissance is not possible, the spots will be marked on the road. Judges of Fact will monitor the correct passing of the chicanes. The list of Judges of Fact will be published on the Official Notice Board. Failure to pass the chicanes in a correct manner will be penalised by 10 sec.

Competitors who will be selected for the final Scrutineering (Stewards' decision) will be scrutineered in auto service “Dalbėra” Valstiečių str.. 21A/ Statybininkų str.. 7A, Zarasai. In case of a protest, the team of car in question is requested to provide proper equipment (including all sealed spare parts) and mechanics at the Final Scrutineering venue. Each selected car will be driven to Final Scrutineering by a designated member of the team (who must be present at the Parc Fermé immediately after notification), and accompanied by an official.

13.2. PROTEST DEPOSIT FEE:

The protest deposits are €150(LARC, LRC).

If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of the car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit as specified in LARC Regulation Art. 10.4.

13.3. APPEAL DEPOSIT FEE

The sum for a national appeal deposit (ASN) is: € 1000.
