INTERNATIONAL SILK WAY RALLY 2021

SANITARY PROTOCOL

This Protocol is an Appendix to the Sanitary Protocol of the International Silk Way Rally 2021

1. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS before the arrival to the city of Omsk.

- Limited social contacts before the departure to Omsk;
- One negative PCR test (taken no later than 72 hours before the arrival to Omsk).

! ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE RECOMMENDED to have substitute personnel in the crew!

2. LOCAL REQUIREMENTS TO BE COMPLIED WITH after the arrival to Omsk.

- Avoid mass gatherings, maintain 1,5 meters of social distance, wear masks, and maintain hand hygiene;
- Take the second PCR test (free-provided) as will be instructed by the Organizers 12 hours after the arrival;
- Avoid and limit social contacts while waiting for the PCR test results.

3. ADMISSION

- Admission to the rally (starting from 29.06.2021) is made after the show of 2 negative PCR tests (The first one taken within 72 hours **before** arriving to Omsk, and the second one taken within 12 hours **after** arriving to Omsk).

4. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS AND TECHNICAL INSPECTIONS

- Schedules for passing inspections, delimiting movement flows between main destinations (Service Park, Administrative and Technical inspections);
- Severe restriction of social interaction (between different teams, as well as between organizer groups);
- The access to the objects is limited only for people who have obtained the admission!
- Strict and constant adherence to sanitary rules (PPE, hand hygiene, social distance);
- Mandatory signing of the Consent to the terms of the official Sanitary Protocol of the Rally.

5. «SILKWAY RALLY» PCR TESTING PROCEDURE

6. DURING THE RALLY (July 2-11, 2021).

a) «SWR Cloud»

The organizers create the "SWR Cloud" zone, subject to strict adherence to the restrictions and the Testing Procedure.

All participants / crew members and organizers with a positive PCR test or symptoms of the disease remain in quarantine at the nearest medical centers / institutions and are not allowed to participate in the rally.

- Accreditation is given from June 30 until July 1, 2021;
- No guests and visitors are allowed on the bivouac;
- To travel to hotels and back (in the host cities during the race), only the declared personal and team transport and official transfers of the rally from/to the Bivouac for organizer groups and crews are used. Taxis and public transport are prohibited!

b) CONTROL AFTER THE «SWR Cloud» ZONE

- **Mobile lab to conduct PCR testing on the Bivouac;**
- **Anti-COVID Command:** control of compliance to all sanitary protocols and support in issues of medical competence;
- **Evacuation in case of a positive PCR test result:** transportation into the nearest town and minimum 7 days of quarantine;

- **In cases of possible contacts with the infected:** trace and identification, testing with self-isolation and/or evacuation from the «SWR Cloud» Zone to make a decision on the COVID status of the delegate.

c) WHILE INSIDE THE «SWR Cloud» ZONE ON THE BIVOUAC

- **Limit social contacts** between different crews and groups of organizers;
- **Control** after the spaces of possible mass gatherings;
- **Public spaces** are specially adapted to comply with the Protocol and regularly disinfected;
- **Constant follow of the sanitary rules** (PPE, hand hygiene, social distancing);
- **Overnight: bivouac resting areas must be distanced apart**, individual tents are highly recommended!
